### CABIN SITE LEASE

WATTER FRONT RECREATION, INC., a Washington corporation, her anofter called Lessor, in

consideration of the rents to be paid and covenants to be performed by filliam C of Mary

hereinofter called Lassen, leases to Lessen the following described cabin site on the terms and conditions stated herein:

Cabin site number 84 of the North Woods as shown in red c Exhibit "A" attached hereto (all distances being approximations), being part of Government Lots 4 and 8, Section 26, Township 7 North, Range 8 East, W.M., Skamania County, Washington, SUBJECT, however to an easement for right of way for access road acquired by the United States of America, United States Forest Service.

### SECTION 1. OCCUPANCY

1.01 Term. This Lease is granted for the period beginning <u>12- 25 5</u>, an terminating on June 1, 2025, unless sooner terminated as hereinafter provided.

1.02 Master Lease. Lessor holds the above described premises under a lease, hereinafter referred to as the "master lease," dated August 11 1970, from the State of Washington, acting by and through the Department of Natural Resources.

1,03 Master Lease Incorporated. The master lease is in file with Lesson and is available for inspection. Lessee's rights hereunder are subject to all the terms, provisions, exceptions and reservations set forth in said master lease (as to which Lessee is a sub-lessee) and incorporated herein by reference, including, without limiting the foregoing deasement for right of way for an access road acquired by the United States of America, United States Forest Jervice and the right of the State of Washington to inspect the premises at reasonable times.

### SECTION 2. RENTAL

2.01 Basic Rental. As rental for each lease year, the Lessee shall pay the sum of Four Hundred

2.02 Rent Adjustments. Lessor may, as of any anniversary date, increase the annual rental as follows:
(a) Under the massar lease, Lessor's rental to the State of Washington may be increased on June 1, 1980, and at intervals of not less than ten (10) years thereafter. Lessor may increase Lessee's rental hereunder at such times as Lessor's rental under the master lease is increased. The amount of such increase that the Lossee shall be responsible for and required to pay shall equal the total rental increase under the master lease to Lessor multiplied by the Lessee's annual rental to the Lessor divided by the Lessee's annual rental to the Lessor divided by the Lessee's engular to the Lessor for the year immediately preceding the year of the increase. The aforesaid formula is illustrated as follows:

Lossee's share of increase under masts: lease x Lessee's annual rental to Lessor

(b) In addition to the increase permitted under subparagraph (a) above, Lessor on the following state, increase the annual rental hereunder on account of taxes and assessments against said real proyuty in an amount, which together with prior increases an account of taxes and assessments, shall not exceed the total of the amount by which taxes and assessments on the land lowered by the master lease exceeds such taxes for 1970, divided by the number of improved cabin sites on said anniversary date.

(c) Finally, every ten years beginning September 1, 1980, the annual rental shall, at the option of the Lessor, be adjusted to reflect the percent of increase from September 1,1970, in the Consumer Price Index as published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics, U.S. Department of Labor; that is, the annual rental each year for the succeeding ten years shall be increased as compared with the annual rental as set forth herein by the same percentage as the increase in said. Consumer Price Index differs from said index for Soptember 1, 1970.

# SECTION C. LESSOR'S CONVENANTS

3,01 Declaration. In order to preserve the natural beauty of the North Woods, to provide for the control of structures erected thereon, improvements to be made thereon, and for the purpose of extending to the residents therein the greatest possible peace, enjoyment, privacy, health, comfort, safety, and preservation of property values, Lessor does ferency certify and declare that with the sole exception of lot 19, which is the North Woods Sales Office, the following reservations, conditions, covenants, agreement and restrictions shall become and are hereby made a part of all leases of property virtin the plat of the North Woods as the same appears on the map survey recorded in the office of the County Auditor of Skamania County, Washington.

\$.02 Boat Dock. Lessor shall construct a boat dock for the common use of residents of the North Woods. In the event construction of said boat dock is not completed by September 1, 1972, it is hereby agreed that in lieu of such construction, Lessor shall contribute \$5,000.00 to the North Woods Association, hereinafter described in paragraph 5.09, for construction of such dock.

## SECTION 4. USE OF SITE

4.01 Permitted Use. The cabin site shall be used only for residential purposes. No building shall be effected, altered, plyced, or parmitted to remain on the cabin site other ti... an one detached single family dwelling and buildings incidental to residential use, and the cabin site shall not be further subdivided into building lots.

4.02 Condition of Site. The premises hereby leased heth bean inspected by Lesses and are accepted in their present condition.

4,03 Vahicles. No vehicles shall be parked in roadv.e.t. Vehicles shall not be operated catelassly or in excess of posted speed v. No vehicle shall be operated at any time without a muttler in good working order. Excessive motor fiolse of annoying smoke are forbidden.

4,04 Maintenants. All lots shall at all times be ket t in a clean, sightly, and wholesome condition and stotrash, garbage, litter, junk, bokes, containers, bottles, cans, machiner, , in plements, lumber, or other building materi ...s whill be permitt. It to be or remain exposed on any lot and visible from any street or adjoining or assroy premise.

4.05 Signs. No signs of any kind shall be displayed to the public view on any lot in the tract except one professional sign, of not more than 18 inches by 24 inches in size, advertising the property for sale or rept, and except signs used by a willder or devalope; to advertise the property during the construction and sales percent

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4.07 Animals. No animals, livestock, or poultry of any kind shall be raised, bred, or kept on any lot, except that part dogs, or other household pets may be kept, but not for any commercial purpose. Household pets shall not be allowed to become an annoyance or nuisence to the neighborhood.

SECTION 6. IMPROVEMENTS continued

- 4.09 Incineration. Because of unpleasent odors and unsightliness, no individual incinerator will be permitted on any lot.
- 4.09 Fires and Fireplaces. Interior fireplaces, stoves, or other type burner must be fireproofed by use of sparkproof screens. All lires must be extinguished before leaving cabin. No fires shall be lit or maintained outside of any cabin.
- 4.10 Firearms and Fireworks. Discharging firearms, firecrackers, rockets or any other fireworks within the North Woods area shall be prohibited.
- 4.11 Commercial Use. No platted lot shall be used for any commercial purpose, except that a Lessee may rent his cabin from time to time, and in such case shall be responsible that his tenants abide by these covenants.
- 4.12 Motorbikes. No motorbike or motorcycle riding of any nature shall be allowed except for ingress and egress.
  - 4.13 Fire Extinguisher. One fire extinguisher (minimum two quart capacity) must be kept in every cabin.
- 4.14 Trailers and Tents. No tent, house trailer, or mobile home, whether the same be on wheels or not, shall be permitted on any lot except during the period of cabin construction and for guests over a weekend period.
- 4.15 Solicitation. There shall be no solicitation or distribution of handbills or circulation of any kind without the written consent of Lessor.
- 4.16 Hose Bibs. One hose bib shall be installed on outside wall of each cabin for fire protection on or before completion of the cabin.

#### SECTION 5. IMPROVEMENTS

- 5.01 Plans Approved. No building shall be erected, placed, or altered on the cabin site until the construction plans showing the location of the structure have been approved by the Lessor as to conformity with plan of development, quality of workmanship and materials, harmony of external design and color with existing structures, and as to location with respect to topography and finish grade elevation. Such approval shall be in writing.
- 5.02 Building Materials. All building construction shall be of log or wood frame. World frame studge or simulated brick veneer construction is expressly prohibited. All roofs shall be of wood shingle or shake or of an acceptable composition color to be approved prior to application by the Lessor or such person or persons designated by Lessor.
- 5.03 Completion. Cabins must be completed from all outward appearance within one (1) year from the time such construction is started. Cabin construction must be start. I within three years from the date of the signing of Cabin 5 to Lease.
- 5.04 Tree Removal. The Lessee of each cabin site may remove from said site all trees, shrubs, and foliage necessary to prepare the property for building subject to the following conditions:
  - As required by the State of Washington in the master lease, any tree whose diameter is over 8" at chest height must be marked by Lossed for Lessor's inspection. Lessor will then notify the Washington State Department of Natural Resources and reque, then standard expraisal of value. Lessee will then pay Lessor for the value of the tree for removal. Any additional clearing beyond that necessary for the construction of improvements shall be prohibited. The intent is to remove as few trees as possible to the end that the community remain natural and rustic.
- 5.05 Lot Markers. Lessee will use all reasonable care to make certain that the lot markers, as established by Lcosor, are not moved or destroyed.
- 5.96 Improvements Other Than On Cabin Site. No improvements of any kind shall be constructed or placed upon any area covered by the master lease without Lessor's prior written consent.
  - 5.07 Owns, ship of Improvements. The master lease provides as follows:
  - "8.04 Ownership of Sub-lessee Improvements. All buildings and Improvements, excluding removable personal property and trade flutures on the leased site [North Woods] "ted by Sub-lessee [Lussee herein] will remain on said site after expiration of this lease [mas an lease] or term atton prior to the term of this lease [master lease] of any sub-lease [this lease] held by the Latte under the provisions of paragraph 5.05; provided, however, upon the expiration of the lease [master lease]. If the State is unsuccessful in re-leasing the leased size [North Woods], as a unit, then each sub-lessee [Lessee herein] shall have a preferential right at allowed by law to re-lease from the State its sub-leased area; provided, further, upon the termination of expiration of this lease [master lease] or a sub-lease (this lease) assigned under paragraph fi.09 that as a condition of any re-lease of the leased site or sub-leased site to any other party made during the three year period following the State shall recurre the subsequent Lessee to purchase the Sub-lease's [Lessee herein] interest in the improvement is as allowed by law. Expiration, as used in this paragraph, shall mean the expiration of the lease as of May 31, 2025."

The parties hereto agree that the terms and conditions of the above quoted paragraph shall be applicable provided:

(a) That Lessee is not in clarault under any of the terms and conditions of this lesse; and (b) That Lessee's lesse expires May 31, 2026. In the event of certic expiration of this lesse, all buildings and improvements located upon the premises shall be the property of Lessor.

4.05 Signs. No signs of any kind shall be displayed to the public view on any lot in the tract except one professional sign, of not more than 18 inches by 24 inches in size, advertising the property for sale or rent, and except signs used by a builder or develope, to advertise the property during the construction and sales period.

4.05 Nuisance. No novious or offensive trade or activity shall be carried on or upon any lot in the tract nor shall anything be done thereon which may be or become an annoyance or nuisance in the area.

### SECTION 6. UTILITIES

6.01 Sewage. Individual sewage disposal systems installed by Lessee must be designed, located, and con structed in accordance with the legal regulations, laws and ordinances of Skamania County and the State of Washington

8.02 Reservation. Lessor reserves to itself and to its successors and assigns easements in under, and along all roads and other common areas in the plat for any utilities whether presently installed or not. In addition, an easement is reserved in an area five (5) feet by ten (10) feet in one corner of each lot (to be selected by Lessor) adjoing the road, for electric transformer vauland/or telephone and power service pedestals if any. And the assignment of the lease as to each individual lot shall be subject to the right to cross over or under the same along the lot lines, with utility lines if such may be necessary in the development of this subdivision or adjoining subdivisions.

6.03 Water. Each cabin site has or will be furnished water at or near the lot line. Each lessee agrees to receive water from the water system supplying the North Woods and forther agrees to pay Lessor \$225.00 for the right to connect to said system

6.04 Maintenance. The lessee shall bear the responsibility and expense of furnishing, installing, back-filling and maintaining each underground trench or other digging upon such cabin site which is necessary for any utility con lections or facilities to serve such cabin site.

### SECTION 7. MISCELLANEOUS

7.01 Lessee's Duties. Lessue agrees to comply strictly with the Lessor's rules and regulations and all applicable Federal, State, County, and Municipal laws, rules and regulations relating to all activities contemplated unid: this lease, including but not limited to, use of public or private roads, parking, fire and prevention of fire, public health, and pollution of streams or lakes, and to assume all obligations thereby imposed upon the Lessor. Lessor may inspect the cabin site and cabin at any time to determine com, ance with the terms of this lease.

7.02 Indemnification. Lessee hereby agrees to assume all risk of, and indemnify and hold harmless, and at the Lesser's expense, defend the Lessor from and against, any claims, loss, cost, legal actions, liability or expense on account of personal injury to or death of any persons whomsoever, including but not limited to employees of the Lessor, or damage to or destruction of property to whomsoever belonging, including but no imited to property of the Lessor which might result from Lessee's activities on the leased premises. The Lesser turner agrees to indemnify and save harmless the Lessor from any loss, cost, suit or expense resulting from Lessee's failure to lomply with any of the provisions of any applicable laws, rules or regulations.

7.03 Insurance. Lessee shall obtain tire, casualty and fiability insurance as follows:

(a) Fire an I casualty insurance in a sufficient, mount to cover the replacement cost of any or all improvements upon the lease I premises. Such insurance shall be carried by a responsible company or companies satisfactory to Lessor and the policy or policie. shall be endorsed an I delivered to Lessor with provision for thirty (30) days' notice of cancellation to Lasson.

(b) Liability and property insurance insuring Lassor and Lessee against all liability for damages to persons (b) Liability and property insura. 7.04 Assignment. Without the prior written consent of Lessor, Lessee shall not assign this lease or any interest therein, or sublet, and no heir, executor, administrator, receiver, trustee in bankruptcy or other assignee by operation of law shall assign or sublease without such written consent.

7.05 Waiver. Any waiver by the stor of any provisions hereof must be in writing, and any of the covenants, conditions, rostrictions, in this lease may be mulled, waived, changed, or modified with respect to all or any portion of sald property by Lessor at any time.

7.06 Attorneys Fees. In the .vent any action, suit, proceeding or appeal therefrom is brought to collect the rent due or to become due hereunder, or any portion thereof, or to get possession of said premises, or to enforce compliance with this lease, or for failure to observe any of the covenants of this lease, the prevailing party shall be entitled to recover such sum as the Court may adjudge reasonable as attorneys' fees to be allowed in said suir, action, proceeding or appeal therefrom in addition to such other relief granted by the Court.

7.07 Condemnation. The parties hereto shall receive any sums or damages paid or awarded by re son of any taking, and empation or acquisition during the existence of this lease as their interests therein shall then appear, whether or not by litigation, by any authority, person or corporation, whether public or private, of any title to or interest in all or any part of the premises.

7.08 Resurvoir Level. The Lessee acknowledges by signing this lease that Pacific Power and Light Company has the right to fluctuate the waters of Swift Reservoir at any time within, the provisions of Federal Power Commission License No. 2111 or as amended. The Lessee shall waive all claims or damage and shall indemnify Pacific Power and Light Company, the State of Washington, Lessor or their successors, if any, against any claim of damage arising from fluctuation in reservoir level or impairment of recreational use of the reservoir or shoreside or floating facilities.

7.09 Validity of Provisions. The determination of any Court that any provisions of this lease are unlawful or void s'vall not affect the validity of any other provision hereof.

7.10 Enforcement of Restrictions. Without in any way limiting the rights of Lessor, if the parties upon whom the provisions hereof are binding, or any of them, shall violate or actempt to violate any of the reservations, restrictions or accompanies hereof, the Lessor or any lessee of land in the tract, shall have the right to compal performance of or compiliance with the provisions hereof, to shate and remove, at the expense of the of fendling lessee or lessees of the property. At that time Lessor shall call a meeting of al! Lessees for the purpose of forming said Association.

8.01 Defailt and Notice. If any default shall be made or the part of the Lessee in the observance or se h, him to be observed or performed and performance of any of the terms, covenants, agreements, or provisions of the set by him to be observed or performed and ruch default continues for sixty (60) days after written notice, the lessor may, at its option, immediately terminate this losse, form it Lessee's interest therein, and forthwith exclude the Lessee from the near respect to such the minimate this but the Lessoe shall nevertheless be liable to the Lessor for all liabilities incurred hereunder prior to such termination. Waives of any default hereunder shall not constitute a waiver of any subsequent default. Sirvice of any notice provided for performance of any of the terms, covenants, agreements, or provisions of the covenants. herein by the Lesser may be made by depositing such notice in the United States mails addressed to the !.essee at

8.02 Master Lease Termination. It is expressly understood that Lessor has leased the premises from the State of Washington for a period ending June 1, 2025. The matter lease provides that in the event it is terminated for any reason whatsoever, prior to the lease termination date, such termination shall operate as an assignment to the State of Washington of this lease together with the unrestricted right of the State to receive payment of the rants herein provided from the date of said assignment

8.03. Failure to Provide Property Report. Lessee shall have the option to void this lease if he does not receive a property report prepared pursuant to the rules and regulations of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, in idvance of on at the rune of, his signing the lease, and Lessee shall have the right to revoke this lease within 48 hours after signing the lease if he out not receive the property report at least 48 hours before signing the lease. However, this option to void the lesses that not apply where Lessee has received the property report and inspected the lot or lots to the lease in advance of signing the lease and acknowledges by his signature that he has made such inspection and has read and inderstands such report.

8.04 Easements. As shown on the plat of "The North Woods", 20 feet easements are reserved to the Lessor and its assigns on the water front portions of Lots 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, and 23 for purposes of community loat docks. Still easements shall not prevent lessees of the above lots from developing their own shoreside docks providing such facilities do not interfere with the bir. Laffic pattern of the community dock system.

Five first easements are reserved to the Lessor and its assigns on the southerly lot line of Lot 10, and the northerly lot line of Lot 11 for access to the water front. Sand access to serve as pathway to hoat docks if it is determined by Lessor that additional boat docks are needed to serve "The North Woods" community.
