It is understood between the parties that the assignment of the said land is subject to the written consent of Pacific Power & Light Company of Portland, Oregon, the successor in interest to the North West Electric Company.

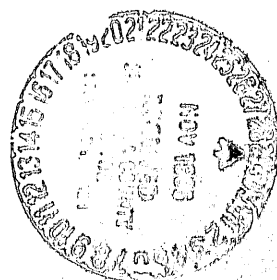

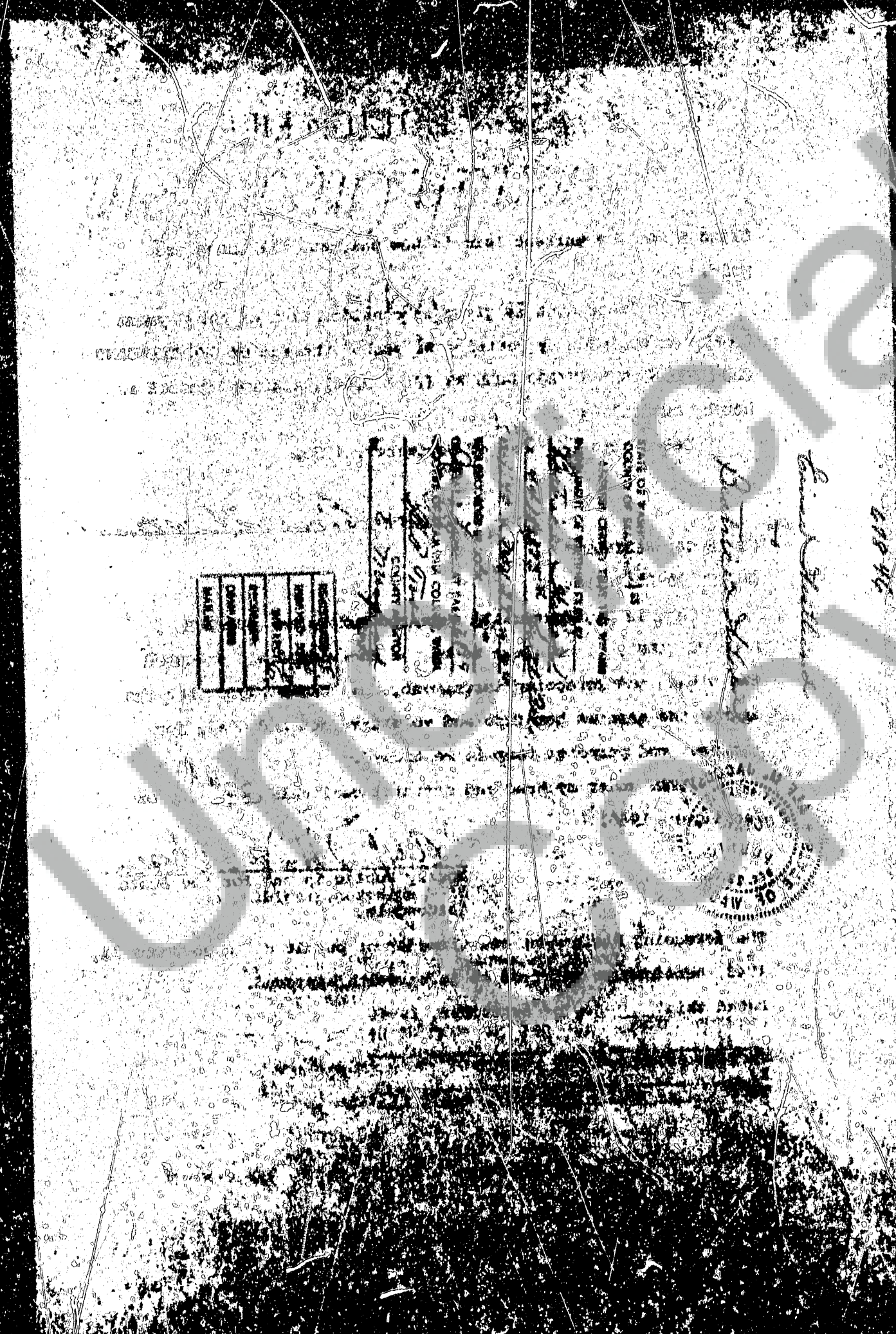
