CABIN SITE LEASE

WATER FRONT RECREATION, INC., a Washington corporation, hareinafter called Lessor, in

Cesin elle number 135 of the North Woods as shown in red on Exhibit "A" attached herato (ell distances being approximations), being part of Government Lots 4 and 8, Section 26, Tox nathp 7 North, Range 6 East, W.M., Skamania County, Washington, SUBJECT, however to an easement for right of way for access road acquired by the United States Forest Service.

SECTION 1. OCCUPANCY

1.02 Master Lease. Lessor holds the above described premises under a lease, hereinafter referred to as the Imaster lease, dated August 11, 1970, from the State of Washington, acting by and through the Department of Waling Resources.

1.03 Master Lease Incorporated. The master lease is on file with Leaser and is available for inspection. I masse's righte hercunder are subject to all \(\cdot\) o terms, provisions, exceptions and reservatio is set forth in said master lease (as to which Lease is r sub-lease) and incorporated herein by reference, including, without limiting the foregoing an exception of way for an access road acquired by the United States of America, United States Forest Service and the right of the States of Washington to inspect the premises at reasonable times.

SECTION 2. RENTAIL

2.01 Basin Rental. As rental for each lease year, the Lessee shall pay the sum of Three Bundred seventy-

Tive and no. (A) lilars (\$ 375.00). Rent shall be paid in advance, on the first day of September in each war, hereinafter referred to as the "anniversary da"." All payments shall be made to Lessor at 9655 S.W. Canyon Road, Fortland, Oregon, or at such other place at which the Lessor may notify the Lesse in writing. Rent for the fraction of any year shall be prorated. The lease year shall be from September 1 through the succeeding August.

2.02 Rent Adjustments. Lessor may, as of any anniversary date, increase the annual rantal as follows:
(a) Under the master lease, Lessor's rental to the State of Washington may be increased on June 1, 1980, and at intervals of not less than ten (10) years thereafter. Lessor may increase Lessee's rental hereunder at such times as Leisan's rental under the master lease is increased. The amount of auch increase that the Lessee shall be responsible for and required to pay shall equal the total rental increase under the master lease to Lessor in "tiplied by the Lessee's annual rental to the Lessor divided by the total annual rental of the Lessea's of the sites in the North Woods. Annual rental as used herein shall mean the total rent the Lessee is required to pay to Lessor for the year immediately preceding the year of the increase. (b) In indition to the increase permitted under subparagraph (a) above, Lessor may as of any anniverse, y dairs, increase the annual rental hereunder on account of taxes and assessments against said real property in an amount, which together with prior increases on account of taxes and assessments, shall not exceed the total of the amount by which taxes assessments on the land covered by the master lease exceeds such taxes for 1970, divided by the number of improved vabin sites on said anniversary date.

(c) Finally, every ten years beginning September 1, 1985, the annual rental shall, at the option of the Lissor, be adjusted to reflect the percent of increase from September 1,1975, in the Consumer Price Index as published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics, U.S. Department of Labor; that is, the annual rental each year for the succeeding ten years shall be increased as compared with the annual rental as set forth herein by the same percentage as the increase in said Consumer Price Index differs from said Index for September 1, 1975.

SECTION 3. LESSOR'S CONVENANTS

3.01 Electration. SECTION 4. USE OF SITE

4.01 Parmitted Use. The cabin site shall be used only for residential purposes. No building shall be effected, altered, placed, or permitted to remain on the cabin site other than one distached ungle family dwelling and buildings incidental to residential use, and the cabin site shall not be further subdivided into building lots.

4.02 Condition of Site. The premises hereby leased have been inspected by Lessee and arc accepted in their present condition.

4.03 Withcles. No vehicles shall be parked in roadways. Vehicles shall not be operated carelessly or in excess of poster speeds. No vehicle shall be operated at any time without a muffler in good working order. Excessive motor properties of the p

SECTION 5. IMPROVEMENTS continued

4.07 Animals. No animals, livestock, or poultry of any kind shall be raided, bred, or kept on any lot, except that exts, dogs, or other household pets may be kept, but not for any commercial purpose. Household pets shall not be allowed to hecome an annoyance of nuisance to the neighborhood.

4.00 Incineration. Because of unpleasant odors and unsignitliness, no individual incinerator will be permitted on any los.

4.0° Fires and Firepizess. Interior firepizess stoves, or other type hurner must be fireproofed by use of sparkproof screens. All fires must be extinguished before leaving cabin. No fires shall be lit or maintained outside of env cabin.

4.10 Firetims and Fireworks. Discharging firetims, firecrackers, rockets or any other fireworks within the North Woods area shall be prohibited.

4.11 Commercial Use. No platted lot shall be used for any commercial purpose, except that a Lessee may rent his cabin from time to time, and in such case shall be responsible that his tenants abide by these covenants.

4.12 Motorbikes. Ma motorbike or motorcycle riding of any nature shall be rillowed except for ingress and egress.

4.13 Fire Extinguishes. One fire extinguisher (minimum two quart capacity) must be kept in every cabia.

4.14 Trailers and Vents. Flo tent, house trailer, or mobile home, whether the same be on wheels or not shall be permitted the any lot except during the period of cabin construction and for guenty over a weekend period.

4.16 Solicitztion. There shall be no solicitation or distribution of bandbills or circulation of any kind without the written consent of Lessor.

6.16 Moza Bibs. One hose bib shall be installed on outside well of each cabin for fire protection on or before completion of the "abin.

SECTION 5. IMPROVEMENTS

6.71 Plans Approved. No building shall be erected, placed, or altered on the cabin site until the construction plans showing the location of the structure have been exproved by the Lessor at to conformity with plan of disvelopment, quality of workmanship and materials, harmony of external design and color with existing structures, and as to location with respect to topography and finish grade elevation. Such approval shall be in writing.

5.02 Building Materials. All building construction shall be of log or wood frame. Wood frame stucco or simulated brick veneer construction is expressly prohibited. All roofs shall be of wood shingle or shake, or of an acceptable composition - color to be approved prior to application by the Lessor or push persons or persons designated by Lessor.

3.03 Completion. Cabins must be completed from all outward uppearance within one (1) year from the time such construction is started. Cabin construction must be started within those years from the date of the signing of Cabin Site Lease.

5.64 Tree Removal. The Lessee of each cabin site may remove from said site #4 trees, shrubs, and foliage

necessary to prepare the property for building subject to, the following conditions:

As required by the State of Washington in the master lease, any tree whose dir meter is carer 8" at cheet height must be marked by Lessee for Lessor's Inspection. Less it will than notify the Washington State Department of Natural Resources and request their standard appraisal of value. Lessee will then pay Lessor for the value of the tree before removal. Any additional clearing beyond that necessary for the construction of improvenents shall be prohibited. The intent is to remove as few trees as possible to the end that the community remain natural and rustic.

5.05 Lot Merkers. Lessee will use all reasonable care to make certain that the lot markers, as established by Lassor, are not moved or destroyed.

5.06 Improvements Other Than Ca Cabir Site. No improvements of any kind shall be constructed or placed upon any area covered by the inaster lease without account prior written consent.

5.07 Ownership of Improvements. The mester lease provides as follows:

*6.5. Owner ip of Sub-lesse Improvements. All buildings and improvements, excluding ramovable personal property and trade fixtures on the leased site [North Woods] erected by Sub-levise [Lessee herein] will remain on sold site after expiration of this lease [master lease] or termination prior to the term of this lease [master lease] of any sub-lesse [rins lease], held by the State under the provisions of paragraph 5.09; provided, however, upon the expiration of the lesse [master lease], if the State is unsuccessful in re-leasing the leased site [North Woods], as a unit, then each sub-lessee [Lessee herein] shall have a preferential right as allowed by law to re-lease from the State its sub-leased area; provided, further, upon the termination or expiration of this lease [master lease] or a sub-lease [this lease] assigned under paragraph 5.09 that as a condition of any re-lease of the leased site or sub-leased site to any other pure made during the three year period following the State shall require the subsequent Lease to purchase the Sub-lessee's [Lessee herein] interest in the improvements as allowed by law. Expiration, as used in this paragraph, shall mean the expiration of the lease as of May 31, 2025.

The parties hereto agree that the terms and conditions of the above quoted paragraph shall be applicable provided:

(a) That Lessee is not in default under any of the serms and conditions of this lease; and (b) That Lessee's lease expires May 31, 2025. In the event of earlier expiration of this lesse, all buildings and insprovements located upon the premises shall be the property of Lessor.

The parties hereto further agree that the benefits of paragraph 8.04 of the mester leare shall be enforceable solely against the State of Washington.

9.08 Taxes and Assessments. The Lessie shall pay in annual payments all taxes and assessments that are now charged or may become chargeable against the improvements placed upon the cabin site, now or in the future, commencing with the taxes first becoming due and payable after the date hereof, all butors such taxes and assessments become

5.09 North Woods Association. The roads in the plai and certain other common areas shall be held in the name of The North Woods Association, a non-profit alsociation, of which the Lessees of lots in the plat shall be members. Said Association shall be responsible for the mainterance and repair of roads, the entire water system including but not limited to water systems serving the cabins on the trentiess, docks and common areas and improvements thereon (if any), as well as other community functions which may be given it by its members. The owners (Lessees) of lots in the tract shall be required to pay dues of not less than one and checkaif dollars (1%) per month and assossments to said Association for their reasonable share of the costs of the functions and dules of the Association. Said dues shall commence at the time 50 lots are lessed. It is understood and agried that Cussor shall and it is hereby delegated to fulfill all duties, responsibilities and functions of the North Wood. Association until fifty (50) lots in the North Woods are lessed. At that time Lessor shall call a meeting of all Lessees for the purpose at forming said Association.

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SECTION 6. UTILITIES

- 6.01 Sewage. Individual sewage disposel systems installed by Lessee must be designed, located, and constructed in accordance with the legal regulations, laws and ordinances of Skamenia County and the State of Washington.
- 6.02 Reservation. Lessor reserves to itself and to its successors and assigns easements in, under along all roads and other common areas in the plat for any utilities whether presently installed or not. In addition, an available ment is reserved in an area five (5) feet by ten (10) feet in one corner of each lot (to be selected by Lessor) activities that road, for electric transformer vault and/or telephone and power service pedestals if any. And the assignment of the lease vito each individual lot shall be subject to the right to cross over or under the same along the lot lines, with utility lines? such may be necessary in the development of this subdivision or adjoining subdivisions.
- 8.03 Water. Each cabin site has or will be furnished water at or near the lot line. Each hisses agrees to receive water from the water system supplying the North Woods and further agrees to pay Lessor \$225.00 for the right to: Jannect to said system.
- 6.04 Maintenance. The lessee shall bear the responsibility and expense of furnishing, installing, back-Willing, and maintaining each underground trench or other dryging upon such cabin sits which is recessary for any utility connections or facilities to serve such cabin site.

SECTION 7. MISCELLANEOUS

- 7.01 Lesse's Duties. Lessee agrees to comply strictly with the Lessor's rules and regulations and all separations and all separations and all activities controlled under this leans, including but not limited to, use of public or private roads, parking, fire and prevention of fire, public health, and politation of streams or lakes, and to assume all obligations thereby imposed upon the Lessor. Lessor may inspect the cabin situ and cabin at any time to determine compliance with the terms of this lease.
- 7.92 Indemnification. Lessee hereby agrees to assume all risk of, and indemnify and hold harmless, and at the Lessee's expense, defend the Lessor from and against, any claims, loss, con legal actions, liability or expense on account of personal injury to or death of any persons whomspever, including but not limited to employees of the Lessor, or damage to or destruction of property to whomspever belonging, including but not limited to property of the Lessor which might result from Lessee's activities on the leased premises. The Lessee further agrees to indemnify and save harmless the Lessor from any loss, cost, suit or expense resulting from Lauree's failure to comply with any of the provisions of any applicable laws, rules or regulations.
 - 7.03 Insurance. Lessee shall obtain fire, casualty and liability insurance as follows:
 - (a) Fire and casualty insurance in a sufficient amount to cover the replacement cost of any or all improve ments upon the leased premises. Such insurance shall be carried by a responsible compliny or companies satisfactory to Lessor and the policy or policies shall be endorsed and delivered to Lessor with provision for thirty (30) days' notice of cancellation to Lesso.
 - (b) Liability and property insurance insuring Lessor and Lessee again, : all liability for damages to persons or property caused by the maintenance, use or occupancy of the lear upremises or by reason of the conduct of any activity carried on therein. Such insurance shall be carried by a responsible company or companies satisfactory to Lessor in amounts not less than the following limits, namely:
 - Bodily injury to or death of any one person, \$5,000.00;
 - Bodily injury or death resulting from any one accident to two or more persons, \$10,000.00, and
 - (3) property damage, \$1,000.00.

Lessage shall deliver to Lessor certificates and receipts evidencing said policies of insurance and further provide with the company or companies for thirty (30) days' notice of cancellation to Lessor.

- 7.94 Assignment. Without the prior written consent of Lesson, Lessee shall not assign this lease or why interest therein, or sublet, and no heir, executor, administrator, receiver, trustee in bankruptcy or other assignee by operation of law shall assign or sublease without such written consent.
- 7.05 Waiver. Any waiver by the Lessor of any provisions hereof must be in writing, and any of the coven-ants, conditions, restrictions, in this lease may be annuited, waived, changed, or modified with respect to all or in portion of said property by Lessor at any time.
- 7.06 Attomsys' Feas. In the event any action, suit, proceeding or appeal therefrom is brought to collect the rent due or to become due hereunder, or any portion thereof, or to get possession of said premises, or to enforce compliance with this lease, or for failure to observe any of the covenants of this lease, the prevailing party shall be entitled to recover such sum as the Court may adjudge reasonable as attorneys' fees to be allowed in said suit, action, proceeding or appeal therefrom in addition to such other relief granted by the Court.
- 7.07 Condamnation. The parties hereto shall receive any sums or damages paid or awarded by reason of any taking, condemnation or acquisition during the existence of this lease as their interests therein shall then appear, whether or not by litigation, by any authority, person or corporation, whether public or private, of any title to or interest in all or any part of the premises.
- 7.08 Reservoir Level. The Lessee acknowledges by signing this wase that Pacific Power and Light right to fluctuate the waters of Swift Reservoir at any time wisk in the provisions of Federal Power Com mission Licenta No. 2111 or as amended. The Lessee shall waive all claims or damage and shall indemnify Pacific Power and Light Company, the State of Washington, Lessor or their successors, if any, against any claim of damage arising from fluctuation in reservoir level or impairment of recreational use of the reservoir or shoreside or floating facilities.
- 7.09 Validity of Provisions. The determination of any Court that any provisions of this lease are unlawful or void shall not affect the validity of any other provision hereof.
- 7.10 Enforcement of Restrictions. Without in any way limiting the rights of Lesson, if the parties upon whom the provisions hereof are binding, or any of them, shall violate or attempt to violate any of the reservations, restrict tions or covenants hereof, the Lessor or any lessee of land in the tract, shall have the right to compel performance of or compliance with the provisions hereof, to abate and remove, at the expense of the offending lessee of lessees of the property of the provisions hereof and to prosecute any proceedings at law or in equity in furtherance of the aforesald remedies in any Court having jurisdiction of such cases.
- 7.11 Reservation on Land. All of the reservations, conditions, coverants, egreements and restrictions.
