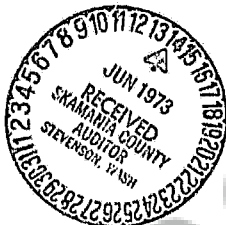


SATISFACTION OF MORTGAGE
