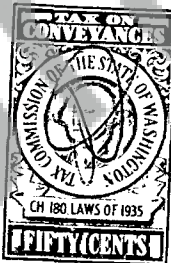
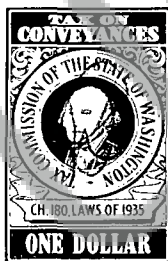
THE GRANTOR, BUD MORBY, dealing with his separate property, and THELMA MORBY, his wife,

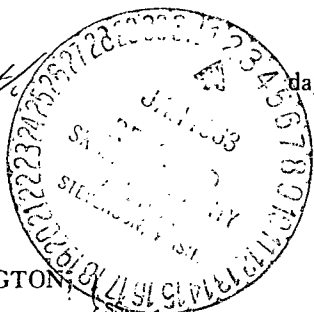
