(5) All advances by the Government as described by this instrument, with interest, shall be immediately due and payable by Borrower to the Government without demend at the place designated in the latest note and shall be secured hereby. No nuch advance by the Government shall relieve Borrower from breach of his covenant to pay. Any payment r, ade by Borrower may be applied on the note or any indebtedness to the Government secured hereby, in any order the Government determines.

(6) To use the loon evidenced by the note solely for purposes outhorized by the Government.

- (7) To pay when due all taxes, liens, Judgments, encumbrances, and assessments lawfully actaching to or assessed against the property, including all charges and assessments in connection with water, water rights, and water stock pertaining to or reasonably necessary to the use of the real property described above, and promptly deliver to the Government without demand receipts evidencing such payments.
- (8) To keep the property insured as required by and under insurance policies approved by, delivered to, and retained by the Government.

(22) Notices given hereunder shall be sent by certified mail unless otherwise required by law, addressed, unless and until some other address is designated in a notice so given, in the case of the Government to Farmers Home Administration, United States Department of Agriculture, at Wenatchee, Washington 90801, and in the case of Borrower to him at his post office address stated above.

(23) If any provision of this instrument or application thereof to any person or circumstances is held invested, such invalidity will not affect other provisions or application; of the instrument which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to that end the provisions hereof are declared to be severable.
