State of Washington:

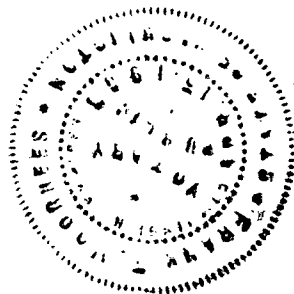
Beginning at a point 801.1 feet south and 919.18 feet west of the
