together with all rights, inferests, easements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, the rents, issues, and profits thereof and revenues and income therefrom, all improvements and personal property now or later attached thereto or reasonably necessary to the use thereof, including, but not limited to, ranges, refrigerators, clothes washers, clothes dryers, or carpeting purchased or financed in whole or in part with loan funds, all water, water rights, and water stock pertaining thereto, and all payments at any time owing to Borrower by virtue of any sale, lease, transfer, conveyance, or condemnation of any part thereof or interest therein all of which are herein called "the property";

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the property unto the Government and its assigns forever in fee simple.

BORROWER for himself, his heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns WARRANTS THE TITLE to the property to the Government against all lawful claims and demands whatsoever except any liens, encumbrances, easements, reservations, or conveyances specified hereinabove, and COVENANTS AND AGREES as follows:

1) To pay promptly when due any indebtedness to the Government hereby secured and to indemnify and save harmless the Government against any loss under its insurence of payment of the note by reason of any default by Borrower. At all times when the note is held by an insured holder, Borrower shall continue to make payments on the note to the Government, as collection agent for the holder.

(2) To pay to the Government such fees and other charges as may now or hereafter be required by regulations of the

Farmers Home Administration. (3) If required by the Government, to make additional monthly payments of 1/12 of the estimated annual taxes, assessments, insurance premiums and other charges upon the mortgaged premises.

(4) Whether or not the note is insued by the Government, the Government may at any time pry any other amounts required herein to be paid by Borrower Ret not paid by him when due, as well as any costs and expenses for the preservation, protection, or enforcement of this I en, as advances for the account of Borrowet. All such advances shall bear interest at the rate borne by the note which has the hignest interest rate.

(5) All advances by the Government as described by this instrument, with interest, shall be immediately due and payable by Borrower to the Government without demand at the place designated in the latest note and shall be secured hereby. No such advance by the Government shall relieve Borrower from breach of his covenant to pay. Any payment made by Borrower may be applied on the note or any indebtedness to the Government secured hereby, in any order the Government determines.

(6) To use the loan evidenced by the note solely for purposes authorized by the Government.

- (7) To pay when due all taxes, liens, judgments, encumbrances, and assessments lawfully attaching to or assessed against the property, including all charges and assessments in connection with water, water rights, and water stock pertaining to or reasonably necessary to the use of the real property described above, and promptly deliver to the Government without demand receipts evidencing such payments.
- (8) To keep the property insured as required by and under insurance policies approved by, delivered to, and retained by the Government.
- (9) To maintain improvements in good repair and make repairs required by the Government; operate the property in a good and husbandmanlike manner; comply with such farm conservation practices and farm and home management plans as the Government. In time to time may prescribe; and not to adandon the property, or cause or permit waste, lessening or impairment of the security covered hereby, or, without the written consent of the Government, cut, remove, or lease any timber, gravel, oil, gas, coal, or other minerals except as may be necessary for ordinary domestic pure these
- (10) To comply with all laws, ordinances, and regulations affecting the property.
- (11) To pay or reimburse the Government for expenses reasonably necessary or incidental to the protection of the lien and priority hereof and to the enforcement of or the compliance with the professions hereof and of the note and any supplementary agreement (whether before or after default), including but not limited to costs of ovidence of title to and survey of the property, costs of recording this and other instruments, attomeys' fees, trustees' fees, mount costs, and expenses of advertising, selling, and conveying the property.
- (12) Neither the property nor any portion thereof or interest therein shall be leased, assigned, sold, transferred or encumbered, voluntarily or otherwise, without the written consent of the Government. The Government shall have the sole and exclusive rights as mortgagee hereunder, including but not limited to the power to grant consents, partial releases, subordinations, and satisfaction, and no posured holder shall have any right, title or interest in or to the lien or any benefits
- (13) At all reasonable times the Government and its agents may inspect the property to pacertain whether the covenants and agreements contained herein or in ray supplementary agreement are being performed.
- (14) The Government may extend and defer the maturity of and renew and resmortize that debt evidenced by the note or any indebtedness to the Government secured hareby, release from liability to the Government any party so liable thereon, release partions of the property from and subordinate the lien hereof, and waive any other rights hereunder, without affecting the lien or priority hereof or the liability to the Government of Borrower or any other party for payment of the note or indebtedness secured hereby except as specified by the Government in writing.
- (15) If at any time it shall appear to the Government that Bo rower may be able to obtain a loan from a production credit association, a Federal land bank, or other responsible cooperative or private credit source, at reatonable rates and terms for loans for similar purposes and periods of time, Borrower will, upon the Government's request, apply for and accept such loan in sufficient amount to pay the note and any indebtedness secured hereby and to pay for any stock necessary to be purchased in a cooperative lending agency in connection with such loan.
- (16) Default hereunder shall constitute default under any other real estate, or under any personal property or other, security instrument held or insured by the Government and executed or assumed by Borrower, and default under any such other security instrument shall constitute default hereunder.
- (17) SHOULD DEFAULT occur in the performance or discharge of any obligation secured by this instrument, or should any one of the parties named as Borrower die or be declared an incompetent, a bankrupt, or an insolvent, or make an assignment for the benefit of creditors, the Government, at its option, with or without notice, may take feel are the entire amount unpaid under the note and any indebtedness to the Government, eachy secured immediately due and payable, (b) for the account of Borrower incur and pay reasonable expenses for repair or maintenance of and take postession of, operate or rent the property, (c) upon application by it and production of this instrument, without other evid mer and without notice of hearing of said application, have a receiver appointed for the property, with the usual powers of receivers in like cases, (d) foreclose this instrument as provided herein or by law, and (e) enforce any and all other mints and remedies provided herein or by present or future law.
- (18) The proceeds of foreclosure rate shall be applied in the following order to the payment of: (a) costs and expenses incident to enforcing or complying with the provisions hereof, (b) any order liens required by law or a competent court to be so paid, (c) the debt evidenced by the note and all indebtedness to the Government secured hereby, (d) inferior liens of record required by law or a competent court to be so paid, (e) at the Government's option, any other indebtedness of Borrower owing to or insured by the Government, and (f) any balance to Borrower. At foreclosure or other sale of all or any part, of the property, the Government and its agents may bid and purchase as a stranger and may pay the Government's share of the purchase price by credifing such amount on any debts of Borrower owing to or insured by the Government, in the order prescribed above.
- (19) As against the debt evidenced by the note and any indebtedness to the Government hereby secured, with respect to the property, Borrower (a) hereby relinquishes, waives, and conveys all rights, included or consummate, of descent, dower, curtesy, homestead, valuation, appraisal, and exemption, to which Borrower is of becomes entitled under the laws and constitution of the jurisdiction where the property ites, and (b) hereby agrees that any right provided by such laws or constitution for indemption or possession following foreclosure sale shall not apply, and that no right of redemption or possession shall exist after foreclosure sale.
- (20) If any part of the loan for which this instrument is given shall be used to finance the purchase, construction or repair of property to be used as an owner-occupied dwelling (herein called "the dwelling") and if Borrower intends to sell or rent the dwelling and has obtained the Government's consent to do so (a) neither Borrower nor according to act for him will, after receipt of a bona fidu offer, refuse to negotiate for the sale or rental of the dwelling or will otherwise make mayallable or deny the dwelling to anyone because of race, color, religion or national origin, and (b) Borrower recognizes as illegal and hereby disclaims and will not comply with or attempt to enforce any restrictive covenants on the dwelling relating to race, color, religior, or national origin.

(21) This instrument shall be subject to the present regulations of the Farmers Home Administration, and to its future regulations not incomistent with the express provisions hereof.

(22) Notices given hereunder shall be sent by certified mail unless otherwise required by law, addressed, unless and until some other address is designated in a notice so given, in the case of the Government to Farmers Home Administration, United States Department of Agriculture, at Wonatchee, Washington 98801, and in the case of Borrower to him at his post office address stated above.

(23) If any provision of this instrument or application thereof to any person or circumstances is held invalid, such invalidity will not affect other provisions or applications of the instrument which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to that end the provisions hereof are declared to be severable.
