WHEREAS, the State of Washington, Department of Matural Resources, did by a certain lease, Lease No. 55985, bearing date of August 11, 1970, as amended by document lated February 10, 1972, as authorized under RCW T9.01.035, demise and lease for purposes stated in the bid for development and use unto Water Front Recreation Inc., a Washington Corporation, all and singular the premises hereinafter described, all as located in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, to wit:

East of the Willemette Meridien, having an area of 88.40 acres, more or less. Subject, however, to an easement for right of way for access road acquired by the United States of America, United States Forest Service; and

WHEREAS, the term of said lease is for a period of fifty-five (55) years from June 1, 1970 to June 1, 2025, subject to a renewal as provided by law Water Front Recreation, Inc., a Vashington Corporation, is to ay to the State of Washington such same at such times at a place designated, all in accordance with the terms of said Lease No. 58985 held in the office of the Repartment of Natural Resources, State of Washington, and as recorded under Auditor's File No. 72521, records of Samania County, Washington; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the terms of the lease and the development plan submitted to the State of Washington, the property herein described is not used principally for agricultural or farming purpuses; and

WHEREAS, Mater Front Recreation, Inc. has submitted, and approved, and recorded in the Office of the Auditor of Skamania County, Washington, a Plat and Survey of the above described property entitled "Mater Front Recreation, Inc." dated May 14, 1971, on file and of record under Auditor's File No. 73635 at page 306 in Book "J" of Miscellaneous Records of Skamania County, Washington, together with appurtenant easement as established in writing on said plat for the joint use of the area shown as roadways on the plat, WATER EPONT RECREATION, INC.

are entering into this mortgage to First Federal Savings and Loan Association of Vancouver to secure an indebtedness, to First Federal Savings and Loan Association. Vancouver of money being loaned by it and borrowed by the mortgager to construct a single family home on lot 93 as shown on the above referred to Plat and Survey, which is a part of the above described plat and survey on record in the office of the Auditor of Skamania County, Washington, and within the metes and bounds of the legal description in lease No. 58935 heretofore described.



NHEREAS, Water Front Recreation, Inc. did with approval of the State of Washington and in conformance with the primary lease heretofore described, make, execute and deliver to the mortgagor herein a document entitled "Cabin Site-Lease", a copy of which is hereto attached and incorporated herein as if set out in full.

NOW THEREFORE, to secure the just indebtedness of the mortgagor, to First Federal Savings and Loan Association of Vancouver,

WATER FRONT RECREATION, INC.

Make the covenants hereimafter stated and mortgages to First Federal Savings and Loan Association of Vancouver, a corporation, mortgagee, their cabin site leasehold interest, on the following real property located in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, to wit:

LOT 93 , as shown on the Plat and Survey entitled Record of Survey for Waterfront Recreation, Inc., dated May 14, 1971, on file and of record under Auditor's File No. 73635, at page 306 of Book "J" of Miscellaceous Records of Skerznia County, Washington, TOGETHER WITH an appurtenent essement as established in writing on said plat, for the joint use of the areas shown as roadways on the plat. SUBJECT TO reservations by the United States of America in approved selection list number 259 dated March 4, 1953, and recorded September 4, 1953, at page 23, of Book 52 of Deeds, under Auditor's File No. 62114, records of Skamania County, Washington as follows:

". . . the provisions, reservations, conditions and limitations of Section 24, Federal Power Act of June 10, 1920, as emended . . and the prior right of the United States, its licensees and permittees to use for tower purposes that part within Power Projects Fos. 2071, 2111, and 256."

The lies of this mortgage shall also extend over and to and shall cover any fixture interest that the mortgager may acquire in the said real property, and also all future equipment, appurtenences, or fixtures, attached to or becoming a part thereof, as such equipment and appurtenences are hereinafter described, and also the reatals, issues and profits of the mortgaged property.

promissory note evidencing this dest which note is of even date with this purtyage and is made, executed and delivered by the mortages to the mortages concurrently with this mortages and as part of this contract.

Also, this cortgage lies shall continue in force and exist as security for any and all other advances which may hareafter be made by the mortgages to the nortgagor, and shall continue in force and exist as security for any debt owing, or hereafter to become owing, by the mortgagor to the mortgages.

The nortgagors coverent that they are the owners of the lessabold interest in the above described premines; that the cine ore now free of enquirance; that this northing is for the benefit of the mortgages for its proper use and benefit for any during all the rest, residue and remainder of said term of years yet to come and unexpired; subject, neverthaless, to the rests, coverants, conditions, and provisions in the indecture of lease mentioned from the State of Washington; that by segment Cocument they have assigned with consent of the State of Vashing too all of their right, title and interest in and to the above described leasehold interest to the cortgegee herein as a part of this transaction and contract to better secure the nortgages; that the State of Washington has consented to the nortgagor entering into this transaction; that they will keep the buildings and other destructible property covered by this nortgage insured against loss by fire, in a sum at least equal to the rortgager's appraised value thereof; such insurance contract shall be issued by a responsible insurance company and the policy evidencing the sens shall be delivered into the possession of the nortgages The said policy shall be endorsed by the mortgager and shall contain an appropriate clause providing that the loss thereinder, if any, shall be payable to the nortgages, in accordance with its interest at the time of loss. The nortgagor further coverants that they will pay promptly all premiums on such insura, ca; and that they will pay promptly before delicquency say and all installments of taxes, special assessments and other governmental levies, together with all restals and payzests required of then under the cabin site lease hereto attached, which may hereaften he levied against or become a lien upon this mortgaged property; that they will keep the buildings and appurtenences on the said property in a good state of regain, all to the effect that the value of the said property shall not be impaired during the life of this cortage.

The nortgagor further covenants and agrees that any and all electric wiring, furnace and heating systems, including water heaters, burners, fuel storage bins and tacks, the plunaing, ventilating, water and irrigition systems, the screens and screen doors, built in mirrors, cupboards, cabinates, and other things of like or similar character, and all trees and garden shades, shall be considered as, and in case of foreciosure of this montgage, adjudicated to as, fixtures, and a part of the nortgaged property, and shall pass to the purchaser at any

execution sale resulting from a foreclosure of this mortgage, and in the absence of foreclosure, and during the life of this mortgage, none of such items shall be removed, nor their value in any way impaired, by the nortgager or their successor. In event Section 5.09 of the master lease referred to below is invoked for the protection of the mortgagee, the above items shall be considered in the same canner as if this mortgage had been foreclosed, or in the event mortgagee obtains possession through any other means the items above referred to shall be considered in like manner.

The mortgagor further coverants and agrees that the loan secured by this mortgage is made upon the personal character and integrity of the mortgagor, as well as upon the security offered, and that therefore they will not convey this mortgaged property, or any interest therein, without the consent of the mortgages, and if any such consent is given, and any such conveyance made, the purchaser or grantee will, personally, assume and agree to pay this debt.

Now if the mortgagor shall fail to pay any installment of principal or interest upon the debt secured hereby or should they fail to perform strictly any other covenants or conditions of this mortgage, or the note evidencing the debt secured hereby, or the covenants, conditions and terms of the lease indenture with Water Front Recreation, Inc., identified and referred to above, then, at the election of the mortgage, the whole debt secured hereby shall become immediately due and payable and mortgage may invoke all or any of the terms of the lease made by the mortgagor with Water Front Recreation, Inc. for the benefit of a lending agency; In addition, those precises in the master lease from the State of Washington to Water Front Recreation, Inc. for the benefit of mortgage are hereby incorporated specifically, and mortgagor agrees to assign their cabin site lease to mortgages herein, referring to, but not limited to, Section 5.03 and Section 5.09, as amended by document dated February 10, 1972, of said lease which state as follows:

"5.08" Insolvency of Lessez. If the Lessez becomes insolvent or bankrupt, or if a receiver is appointed, the State may carcel, at its option, the lease unless the lease has been used as collateral with the State's consent. If the Lessee should default in a p yment to the lending agency, the State, upon request by the lender, shall assign the lease to the lending agency who may, thereafter, either operate the leased site or, with the approval of the State, assign the lease.

"5.00" Status of Sub-leases. Termination of this lease, by cancellation or otherwise, prior to the lease termination data, shall not serve to cancel approved sub-leases, nor derrogate from the rights of the lienholders of record, but shall operate as an assignment to the State of any and all such sub-leases, together with the unrestricted right of the State to receive all sub-lease payments therein yrovided for from the date of said assignment. Upon termination of this lease, by cancellation or otherwise, prior to the termination date of said lease, the Leasee shall have no claim to sub-lease payments and/or sub-lease improvement values have in contained."

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Or mortgages may immediately foreclose this nortgage and the property covered by this nortgage may be sold as provided by law, and in event of such assigns at a foreclosure cale or the invoking of any other reachy provided by law by the mortgages, shall be a perpetual bar, both in law and equity, against the mortgager and against all persons claiming or to claim the premises, or any part thereof by, from, through or under the mortgagor or any of them.

At election of mortgagee; if it so desires, it mortgagor shall fail to pay any installment of taxes, special assessments or other governmental levies that may become due, or if they shall fail to purchase and pay the premium on any policy of insurance, then the mortgagee may pay or advance such sums as may be necessary to pay such tax assessments, or governmental levy, or such insurance premium, and the exount so paid shall be added to end become a part of the foot secured hereby.

The mortgagor further agrees that if they and fail to make the payments as herein provided, or should they fail to perform any other covenant or condition of this contract, and in case of a foreclosure action, they agree to pay, in addition to the principal and interest then due, and in addition to any items of expense as are above mentioned, such sur as the court may adjudge reasonable as attorney's fees in such foreclosure action.

The mortgager further represents that the funds loaned by the mortgages and secured by this mortgage are to be used for improvements of the mortgaged premises.
