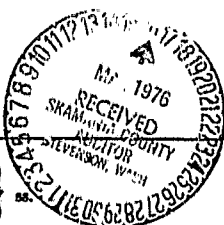
THE MORTGAGORS, LLOYD A. LASSEY and MARY LOU LASSEY, husband and wife,

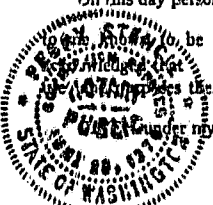
