

CERTIFICATE OF ABANDONMENT

On November 6, 1951, Harbor Plywood Corporation conveyed an easement to the United States of America, acting by and through the Forest Service, U.S.D.A., which easement was recorded on February 5, 1952, records of Skamania County, Washington.


Said easement provides that it is "to locate, construct, relocate, maintain, patrol and repair a telephone transmission line."

Said easement also provides that it "shall continue so long as deemed necessary or desirable by the Government for the control, management and administration of the National Forest or the resources thereof, but if for a period of five years the Government shall cease to use the rights, privileges and easement hereby granted . . . then in any such event this easement shall terminate and all rights hereunder shall revert to Harbor, its successors and assigns."

The Forest Service has no present or reasonably foreseeable future need for said easement and said easement is not now being used by the Forest Service and the use thereof has been discontinued.

An appraisal of said easement indicates that it has no market value and is of no value to the Forest Service. Under the circumstances, it would appear to be an unreasonable burden on the Forest Service to retain said easement on inventory and said easement is hereby declared abandoned by the Forest Service.

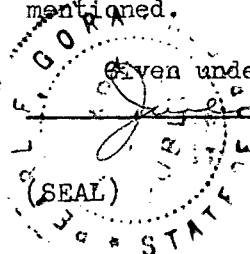


