COMMUNITY PROPERTY AGREEMENT

THIS COMMUNITY PROPERTY AGREEMENT made and entered into this 12th day of April, 1963, by and between TROY E. BOWMAN and EMMA E. BOWMAN, husband and wife, both of Clark County, Washington,

W I T N E S S E I H:

WHEREAS, the parties hereto are the owners of certain property situate in the State of Washington, consisting of real and personal property and whereas the parties contemplate acquiring more property in the future, and

WHEREAS, the parties are desirous of their property passing to the survivor without delay or expense in the event of the death of either of them;

NOW THEREFORE, we TROY E. BOWMAN and EMMA E. BOWMAN, for and in consideration of the love and affection which we have one for the other, do mutually agree that all of the property which we have separately, jointly or otherwise, and whether real, personal or mixed and wheresoever situate shall be and it hereby is declared to be community property, and each of the parties hereto does hereby convey and transfer to the other party and to the community composed of them all property owned by them, even though the same be held in his or her separate capacity; and

IT IS HEREBY AGREED that all of the property which we may acquire in the future whether real, personal or mixed and wheresoever situate and whether acquired jointly, separately or otherwise be and it hereby is declared to be community property and each of the parties hereto does hereby convey and transfer to the other party and to the community composed of them, all such property hereafter acquired by them even though the same be acquired in his or her separate capacity; and

IT IS FURTHER AGREED that the whole of the community property now owned by us or hereafter acquired by us shall at once, in the event of the death of TROY E. BOWMAN while the said EMMA E. BOWMAN survive, be vested in EMMA E. BOWMAN, the real property in fee simple and the personal property

absolutely as her sole and separate property; and in the event of the death of the said EMMA E. BOWMAN, leaving the said TROY E. BOWMAN surviving her, the whole of said community property now owned by them or hereafter acquired by them shall at once vest in the said TROY E. BOWMAN, the real property in fee simple and the personal property absolutely, as his sole and separate property.

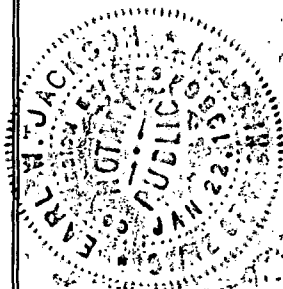
