ORDER APPROVING FINAL ACCOUNT  
AND DECREE OF DISTRIBUTION

This matter came on regularly for hearing in open Court on the final account and petition for distribution herein, the administratrix appearing personally and with her attorney, Dale V. Whitesides of Robinson, Landerholm, Memovich, Lansverk, Whitesides and Marsh, and the court, having heard the evidence and being fully advised, finds that:

1. Due and proper notice of this hearing has been given in the form and manner required by statute and court rule.
2. Edward Games Peterson, a/k/a Edward G. Peterson, died intestate on June 21, 1965, at Vancouver, Washington, being at the time of his death a resident of Yacolt, Clark County, Washington, and leaving estate subject to administration in Clark County, Washington, which was the community property of himself and Bertie E. Peterson, his surviving wife.
3. Bertie E. Peterson was confirmed as administratrix on July 9, 1965, immediately qualified as such and at all times since has been and is now the duly appointed, qualified and acting administratrix herein.
4. She gave notice of her appointment and to creditors of this estate in the form and manner required by law, the first publication having been made on July 16, 1965, and the time for filing claims against this estate has now wholly expired and no claims have been filed herein.
5. This estate was appraised at \$19,733.18 and there is no inheritance tax due the State of Washington and the inheritance

1 Tax Release is filed herein, and there was no federal estate tax  
2 due to the United States of America.

4 6. No detailed statement of the receipts and disburse-  
5 ments of the administratrix, as such, was made, nor is one required,  
6 for the reason that the administratrix, who is the surviving wife  
7 and only heir of Edward Ganes Peterson, a/k/a Edward G. Peterson,  
8 deceased, will receive the entire estate.

9 7. Edward Ganes Peterson a/k/a Edward G. Peterson left  
10 surviving him as his only heir, his wife, Gertie E. Peterson of  
11 400 Yacolt Road, Yacolt, Washington. He left surviving him no  
12 children or children of deceased children nor had he ever adopted  
13 children.

14 8. Gertie E. Peterson is the surviving wife of Edward  
15 Ganes Peterson a/k/a Edward G. Peterson and is the sole heir of  
16 his estate and is entitled to be awarded the entire estate.

17 9. This estate is now ready to be distributed. The  
18 administratrix should pay the reasonable sum of \$485.80 for their  
19 services herein and should reimburse them for the expenses of  
20 administration, in the sum of \$ 80.45, advanced by them, together  
21 with such other incidental expenses of transferring title to the  
22 property herein distributed as may be incurred.

23  
24 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND  
25 DECREED as follows:

26 1. The administratrix has performed each and every act  
27 and duty required of her and her accounting as such administratrix  
28 is hereby in all respects approved, confirmed and allowed.

29 2. There were no creditor's claims and no estate and  
30 inheritance taxes due and owing to the United States of America  
31 and the State of Washington.

32 3. All of the rest, residue and remainder of the  
property of this estate, to-wit:

The following real property in Clark County, Wash:

The fractional North half of the northwest quarter (N $\frac{1}{2}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section One (1), Twp 4 North, Range 3 East of N.M., subject to an easement for a water pipe line granted to the Town of Tacolt by the Clarke County Timber Company under date of Feb. 18, 1911, also reserving to Weyerhaeuser Timber Co., and to its successors and assigns, the right to use and occupy a road now constructed, located and in use across the above described land.

EXCEPT: That portion of the SW quarter of the NW quarter of Section 1, Twp 4 North, Range 3 E., W.M., lying Southwesterly of the County Road.

The following real property in Skamania County, Wash:

The south half (S $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the south half (S $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 15, Township 4 North, Range 7 E.W.M.,
