

DEED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: The Grantor, SKAMANIA COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of Washington, does hereby convey and quit claim to THE PORT OF SKAMANIA COUNTY, a municipal corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Washington, the Grantee, the following described real estate situated in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, to-wit:

Beginning at a point of intersection of South boundary line of Spokane, Portland and Seattle Railroad right-of-way with intersection of Kanaka Creek, Section Thirty-six (36), Township Three (3) North, Range Seven and one-half (7½) East of the Willamette Meridian, said point being the North-west corner of Thompson property South along South to S. E. corner boundary of Railroad right-of-way in WLT course with East boundary line of Riverview Addition; South 34°30' East to Southeast corner of Front Street of Riverview Addition in Section Six (6), Township Two (2) North, Range Seven and one-half (7½) East of the Willamette Meridian; thence following the South Boundary of Front Street South 55°30' West to said point North 55°30' East 637 feet from the Southeast corner of Stevenson; thence South to the meander line of Columbia River; thence Easterly on meander line to point 34°30' East of said point that is North 55°30' East 40 feet of the Southeast corner of Block Two (2) of Riverview Addition North 34°30' West to said point North 55°30' to East 40 feet of Southeast corner of Block Two (2) of Riverview Addition North 34°30' West 118 feet; thence North 55°30' East to center of Kanaka Creek; thence following center of Kanaka Creek in Northerly direction to point of beginning.

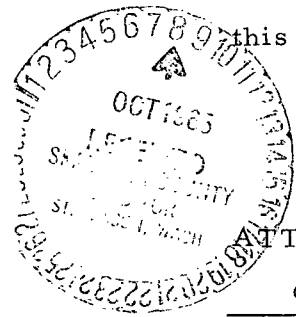
