

CERTIFICATE OF ABANDONMENT

On May 25, 1943, John Stenger conveyed an easement for a reservior and pipe line to the United States. Said easement was recorded June 26, 1943, in Book 29 of Deeds at page 465, Skamania County, Washington.

No consideration was paid for the easement.

A careful appraisal of the easement indicates that it has no commercial or other value.

The Forest Service has no present or foreseeable future need for the easement. Under the circumstances it would appear to be an unjustified burden to retain said easement on inventory and said easement is therefore abandoned by the Forest Service.

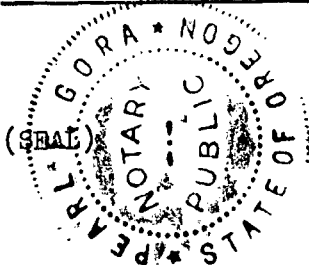
