## CERTIFICATE OF ABANDONMENT

On August 31, 1916, Ole Peterson conveyed an easement for a telephone and telegraph line to the United States. Said easement was recorded February 11, 1918, in Book Q of Deeds at page 420, Skamania County, Washington.

No consideration was paid for the easement.

A careful appraisal of the easement indicates that it has no commercial or other value.

The Forest Service has no present or foreseeable future need for the easement. Under the circumstances it would appear to be an unjustified burden to retain said easement on inventory and said easement is therefore abandoned by the Forest Service.
