

EXECUTOR'S DEED



## SUBJECT TO:

- (1) A perpetual easement and right of way for the purpose of transmitting microwave beams over a strip of land 100 feet in width, and the right to remove trees in connection with the operation of a microwave radio relay station site in the Southeast Quarter of Section 4, Township 2 North, Range 6 E.W.M., granted to Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company, a corporation, by deed dated October 20, 1954, and recorded November 30, 1954, at page 53 of Book 39 of Deeds, under Auditor's File No. 47901, Records of Skamania County, Washington.
- (2) A perpetual easement and right of way for the purpose of transmitting microwave beams over a strip of land 100 feet in width, and the right to remove trees, timber and man-made structures therefrom, granted to Oregon-Washington Railroad & Navigation Company, an Oregon corporation, and Union Pacific Railroad Company, a Utah corporation, by deed dated May 26, 1961; recorded July 21, 1961, at page 78 of Book 49 of Deeds, under Auditor's File No. 58708, Records of Skamania County, Washington.
- (3) Easements and rights of way for public roads, if any, over and across the real estate under search.
