in legal money of the United States of America, together with interest thereon according to the terms and conditions of one or more promissory notes now be hereafter executed by this murigagor and to secure the payment of such additional money as may be leaned hereafter by the mortisage to the mortisager for the purpose of repairing, removating, altering, adding to or improving the mortisaged property, or any plat thereof, or for any other purpose whisever, the following described real property, and all interest or estate therein that the mortager may hereafter acquice, together with the income, rents and profits therefrom, situated in the County of Skernerrie State of Washington, to-wit:

Commencing at a point on the next line of Second Street, 410 feet West and 542 feet South of Northeast corner of Lot 9, Section 1, Township 2 North, Range 7 EMM, as following: Thence West 100 feet along North line of 2nd Street; thence North 100 feet thence East 100 feet; thence South 100 feet to point of beginning.

together with the appurtenances, fixtures, strachments, tenemonts and hereditaments belonging or appertaining thereto, including all trees and shubs, all awnings, screens, mantels, linoleum, refrigeration and other house service equipment, venetian blinds, window shudes and all plumbing, lighting, heating (including oil burnes), cooling, ventilating, elevating and watering apparatus and all fixtures now or hereafter belonging to or used in connection with the property, all of which shall be construed as part of the realty.

The mortgagor covenants and agrees with the mortgage as follows: that he is lawfully seized of the property in fee simple and has good right to mortgage and convey it; that the property is free from all liens and incumbrances of every kind; that he will keep the property free from any incumbrances prior to this mortgage; that he will pay all taxes and assessments levied or imposed on the property and/or on this mortgage; that he will not cermit waste of the property; that he will keep all buildings now or hereafter placed on the property in good order and repair and unceasingly ins gred against loss or damage by fire to the extent of the full insurable value thereof in a company acceptable and approved by the mortgage and for the mortgage's benefit, and will deliver to the mortgages that if the mortgage indebtedness is evidenced by more than one note, the mortgage my credit nav-

The mortgagor agrees that if the mortgago indebtedness is evidenced by more than one note, the mortgagoe may credit payments received by it upon any of said notes, or part of any payment on one note and part on another, as the mortgage may elect. The mortgagee reserves the right to refuse payments in excess of those specified in the note agreement or payment of the debt in whole, unless otherwise provided in the note or notes given with this mortgage.

The mortgagor shall not move or alter any of the structures on the mortgaged premises without consent of the mortgagee, all improvements placed thereon shall become a part of the real property mortgaged herein.

Should the mortgagor default in any of the foregoing covenants or agreemen's, then the mortgagee may perform the same and may pay any part or all of principal and interest of any piter incumbrances or of mustance premiums or other charges secured hereby, and any amounts so paid, with interest thereon at the highest legal rate from date of payment shall be repayable by the murtgager on demand, and shall also be secured by this mortgage without water or any right or other remedy arising from breach of any of the covenants hereof. The mortgage shall be the sole judge of the validity of any lax, assessment or lien asserted against the property, and payment thereof by the mortgagee shall establish the right to recover the amount so paid with interest.

Time to of the essence hereof, and if default be made in the payment of any of the sums hereby secured or in the performance of any of the covenants or agreements herein contained, then in any such case the remainder of unpaid principal, with accrued interest and all other indebtedness hereby secured, shall at the election of the mortgagee become immediately due without notice, and this mortgage shall be foreclosed.

In any action to foreclose this mortgage or to collect any charge growing out of the vicit hereby secured, or any suit which the mortgages may be obliged to defend to protect the unimpoired priority of the lien hereof, the mortgager agrees to pay a reasonable sum at atturney's fee and all costs and expenses in connection with such suit, and also reasonable cost of scarching records, title company costs, which sums shall be secured hereby and included in any decree of foreclosure.

Upon bringing action to foreclose this mortgage or at any time which such proceeding is pending, the contagage, without notice, may apply for and secure the appointment of a receiver for the mortgaged property or any part thereof, and the income, rents and profits thereform. The mortgager hereby consents that in one action brought to foreclose this mortgage, a deficiency had not application of the proceeds of the mortgaged property. Portgagors shall not assign this contract in whole or in part without first braining the written consent of the mortgagees therein.
