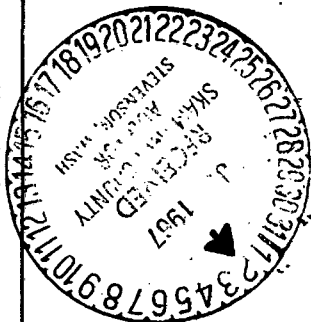

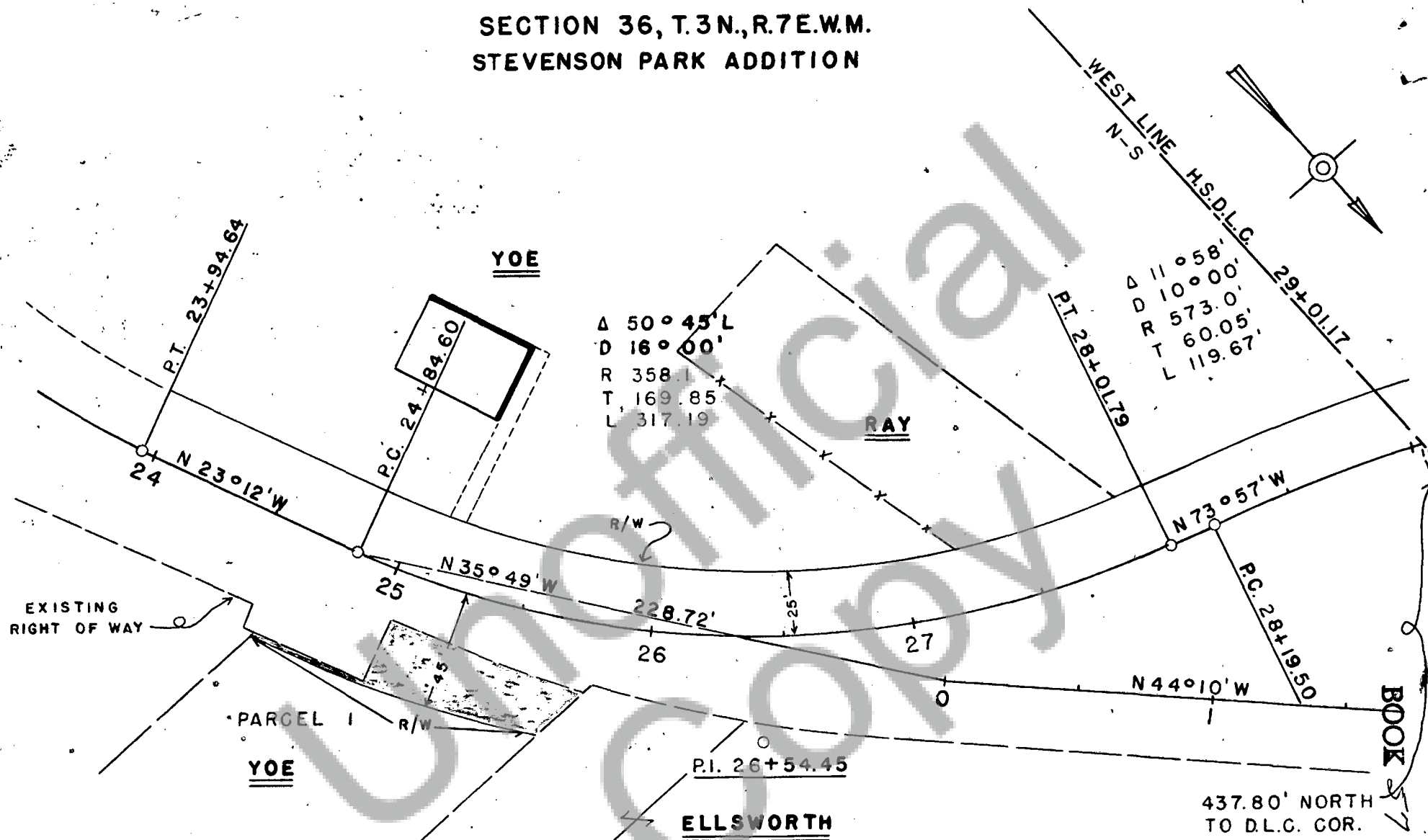


EXHIBIT MAP "A"
