Grantor hereby irrevocably grants, bargains, sells and conveys to Trustee in trust, with power of sale, the

appertaining, and the rents, issues and profits thereof; and all fixtures now or nerestor thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and the rents, issues and profits thereof; and all fixtures now or hereafter attached to or used in connection with the premises herein described; and in addition thereto the following described nousehold appliances, which are and shall be deemed to be, fixtures and a part of the realty, and are a portion of the security for the indebtedness herein mentioned:

To the extent that any of the property described herein may be subject to the provisions of the Uniform Commercial Code, this deed of trust is a security agreement, granting to beneficiary, as secured party, a security interest in any such property and the grantor agrees to execute such financing statements as may be required by the beneficiary and pay, upon demand, filling fees for any such financing statements and continuations those of.

The real property conveyed by this deed of trust is not used principally for agricultural or farming purposes,

THIS DEED, IS FOR THE PURPOSE OF SECURING PERFORMANCE of each agreement of Grantor herein contained and payment of the sum of FIFTY THOUSAND AND NO/100 --

(\$50,000,00) with interest thereon according to the terms of a promissory note of even date herewith, payable to the erder of Beneficiary and made by Grantor; and also such further sums as may be advanced of loaned by Beneficiary to Grantor, or any of their successors or assigns, together with interest thereon at such rate as shall be agreed upon.

The Grantor covenants and agrees as follows:

- 1. That he will pay the indebtedness, as hereinbefore provided. Privilego is reserved to prepay at any time, without premium or fee, the entire indebtedness or any part thereof not less than the amount of one installment, or one hundred dollars (\$100,00), whichever is less. Prepayment in full shall be credited on the date received. Partial prepayment, other than on an installment due date, need not be credited until the next following installment due date or thirty days after such prepayment, whichever is earlier.
- Grantor agrees to pay to Beneficiary together with and in addition to the monthly payments of principal and interest payable under the terms of the note secured hereby, on the first day of each month until said note is fully paid.
 - (a) A sum, as estimated by the Beneficiary, equal to the ground rents, if any, and the taxes and special assessments next due on the premises covered by this Deed of Trust, plus the prevalums that will next become due and payable on such insurance policies as may be required under paragraph B hereof, satisfactory to Beneficiary, Grantor agreeing to deliver promptly to Beneficiary all bills and notice, therefor, less all sums already paid therefor divided by the number of months to clapse before one (1) month prior to the date when such ground rents, posmiums, taxes and assessments will become delinquent, such sums to be held by the Beneficiary in trust to pay said ground rents, remniums. I save doit a neglal assessments. rents, premiums, taxes and special assessments.
 - (b) All payments mentioned in the preceding subsection of this paragraph and all payments to be made under the note secured hereby shall be added together and the aggregate amount thereof shall be paid by the Grantor each month in a single payment to be applied by Beneficiary to the following items in the order set forth:
 - ground rents, if any, taxes, special assessments, fire and other hazard insurance premiums;
 Interest on the note secured heroby; and
 amortization of the principal of said note.

(c) Any deficiency in the amount of any such aggregate monthly payment shall, unless made good by the Giantor prior to the due date of the next such payment, constitute an event of default under this Deed of Trust. The arrangement provided for in paragraph 2 is solely for the added protection of the Beneficiary and entails no respirably by on the Baneficiary's part beyond the silowing of due credit, without interest, for the sums actually received by it. Upon assignment of this Deed of Trust by the Beneficiary, any funds on hand shall be turned over

to the assignee and any responsibility of the assignor with respect thereto shall terminate. Each transfer of the property that is the subject of this Deed of Trust shall automatically transfer to the Grantee all rights of the Grantee with respect to any funds accumulated noreunder.

- 3. At beneficiary's option grantor will pay a "late charge" not exceeding four per centum (4%) of any installment when paid more than fifteen (15) days after the due date thereof to cover the extra expense involved in handling delinquent payments, but such late charge shall not be payable out of the proceeds of any sale made to satisfy the indebtedness secured thereby. Unless such proceeds are sufficient to discharge the entire indebtedness and all proper costs and expenses secured thereby.
- 4. If the total of the payments made under (a) of paragraph 2 shall exceed the amount of payments actually made by Beneficiary for ground rents, taxes, assessments and insurance premiums, such excess may be credited by Beneficiary on subsequent payments to be made by Grantor, If, however, the monthly payments made under (a) of paragraph 2, shall not be sufficient to pay ground rents, taxes, assessments and insurance premiums, when the same shall become due and payable, Grantor shall pay to Beneficiary any amount necessary to make up the deficiency on or before the date when the payment of such ground rent, taxes, assessments, or insurance premiums shall be due. If at any time Grantor shall tender to Beneficiary, in accordance herewith, full payment of the entire indebtedness secured hereby, Beneficiary shall, in computing the amount of indebtedness, credit to the account of Grantor any credit balance remaining under the provisions of (a) of paragraph 2. If there shall be a default under any of the provisions of this Deed of Trust and thereafter a sale of the premises in accordance with the provisions hereof, or if the Beneficiary in the funds accumulated under (a) of integraph 2, less such sums as will become due and payable during the pendency of the proceedings, as a credit against the amount of principal then remaining unpaid under said note.
- To keep the property in good order and condition and not to commit or permit any waste thereof. To allow Beneficiary to inspect the property at any time during reasonable hours.
- 6. To complete or restore promptly and in good workmanlike manner any building or improvement which may be constructed, damaged or destroyed thereon, and pay when due all costs incurred therefor, and, if the loan secured hereby or further agrees:
 - -, To commence construction promptly and in any event within thirty (30) days from the date of the commitment of the Beneficiary, and complete same in accordance with plans and specifications satisfactory to Beneficiary.
 - (b) To complete all buildings or other structures being or about to be built they on within six (6) months from date hereof,
 - (c) To replace any work or materials unsatisfactory to Beneficiary, within fifteen (15) days after written notice to Grantor of such fact,
 - (d) That work shall not cease on the construction of such improvements for any reason whatsoever for a period of fifteen (15) consecutive days.

The Truttee, upon presentation to it of an affidavit signed by Beneficiary, setting forth facts showing a default by Grantor under this numbered paragraph, is authorized to accept at izue and conclusive all facts and statements therein, and to act thereon hereunder.

- Not to remove or demonst any building, improvements thereon or any fixtures or other property in or used in connection with said building or improvements.
 - 8. To comply with all laws, ordinances, regulations, covenants, conditions and restrictions affecting said properly.
- 9. To keep the buildings, improvements and fixtures now existing or hereafter erected on the mortgaged property insured as may be required from time to time by the Leneficiary against loss by fire and other hazards, casualties and contingencies in such amounts and for such periods as may be required by the Beneficiary and will pay promptly, when due, any premiums on such insurance provisions for payment of which has not been made hereinbefore. All insurance shall be carried in companies approved by the Beneficiary and the policies and renewals thereof shall be held by the Beneficiary and have attached thereto loss payable clauses in favor of and in form acceptable to the Beneficiary. In event of loss Grantor will give immediate notice by mail to the Beneficiary, who may make proof of loss if not made promptly by Grantor, and each insurance company concerned is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for such loss directly to Beneficiary instead of to Grantor and Beneficiary pointly, and the insurance proceeds, or any part thereof, may be applied by the Beneficiary at its option either to the reduction of the indehtedness hereby caused or to the restoration or repair of the property damaged. In event of forcelosure of this Deed of Trust or other transfer of title to the subject property in the indehtedness secured hereby, all right, title and interest of the Grantor in and to any insurance policies then in force shall pass to the purchaser or grantee.
- 10. To appear in and defend any suif, action or proceeding that might affect the value of this security instrument or the security itself or the rights or powers of Beneficiary or Trustee; and should Beneficiary or Trustee elect also to appear in or defend any such action or proceeding the Grantor will, at all times, indemnify from, and, on demand reimburse Beneficiary or Trustee for any and all loss, damage, expense or east, including cost of evidence of title and attorney's fees, attsing out or or incurred in connection with any such suit, action or proceeding, and the sum of such expenditures shall be secured by this Deed of Trust with interest as provided in the note secured hereby and shall be due and payable on demand. To pay all costs of suit, cost of evidence of title and a reasonable attorney's fee in any proceeding or suit brought by Beneficiary to foreclose this Deed of Trust.
- 11. To pay at least ten (10) days before delinquent all rents, taxes, assessments and encumbrances, charges or liens with interest, that may now or hereafter be levied, assessed or claimed upon the property that is the subject of this Deed of Trust or any part thereof, which at any time appear to be prior or superior hereis for which provision has not been made heretofore, and upon request will exhibit to Beneficiary offig at receipts thereby, and to pay all taxes, reasonable costs, fees and expenses of this Trust; on default hereunder Beneficiary may, at its option, pay, or pay out of reserves accumulated under paragraph 2, any tuch sums, without waiver of any other right of Beneficiary by reason of such default of Granter, and Beneficiary shall not be liable to Granter for a failure to exercise any such option.
- 12. To repay immusilities, or written notice to Grantor all, and the advanced hereunder by or on behalf of Beneficiary or Trustee, with increas from the data of such advance the state in additive at the rate provided on the grantial debt, and the repayment thereat shall be secure hearby. Failure to repay such expenditure or advance and interest thereas within ten (10) days of the mailing of such notice with at Beneficiary's option, constitute an event of default described or a failure against Grantor for the accovery of such expenditure by odvance and interest, hereon, and in such event Grantor agrees to pay, in addition to the amount of such expenditure or advance, all costs and he penses incurred in such action, together with it reasonable attorney's fee.
- 13. Upon the request of the Beneficiary, the Grantor shall execute and deliver a supplemental nate or notes for the sum or turns advanced by the beneficiary for the alters, in modernization, improvement, maintenance or repair of said premises, for taxes or assessments against the same and inv other purpose authorized hereunder, faid note or notes shall

be secured hereby on a parity with and as fully as if the advance evidenced thereby were included in the note first described above. Said supplemental mets, or notes shall bear interest at the rate provided for in the principal indebtedness and shall be payable in approximately equal monthly payments for such period as may be agreed upon by the Grantor and Beneficiary. Failing to agree on the maturity, the whole of the sum or sums so advanced shall be due and payable thirty (30) days after domaind by the Beneficiary. In no event shall the maturity extend beyond the ultimate maturity of the note first described above.

14. If the indebtedness secured hereby be guaranteed or insured under Title 38 United States Code, such Title and Regulations issued thereunder and in effect on the date hereof shall govern the rights, duties and liabilities of the parties hereto, and any provisions of this or other instruments executed in connection with said indebtedness which are inconsistent with said Title or Regulations are hereby amended to conform thereto.

IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED THAT:

- 15. Should Grantor fall to make any payment or to do any act as herein provided, then Beneficiary or Trustee, but without obligation so to do and without notice to or demand upon Grantor and without releasing Grantor from any obligation hereof, may: Make or do the same in such manner and to such extent as either may deen necessary to protect the security hereoff Beneficiary or Trustee being authorized to enter upon the property for such purposes, commence, appear in and defend any action or proceeding purporting to affect the security hereof or the rights or powers of Beneficiary or Trustee; pay, hurchase, contist, or compromise any encumbrance, charge or lien which in the judgment of either appears to be prior or superior hereto; and in exercising any such powers, incur any liability, expend what ever amounts in its absolute discretion it may deem necessary therefor including cost of evidence of title, employ counsel, and pay his reasonable fees.
- 16. Should the property or any part or appurtenance thereof or right or interest therein be taken or damaged by reason of any public or private it provement, condemnation proceeding, fire, earthquake, or in any other mancer, Beneficiary may, at its option, commence, appear in and prosecute, in its own name, any action or proceeding, or make any compromise or settlement, in connection with such taking or damage, and obtain all compensation, awards or other relief therefor. All such compensation, awards, damages, rights of action and proceeds, including the proceeds of any policies of insurance affecting the property, are hereby assigned to Beneficiary who may, after deducting therefrom all its expenses, including attorney's fees, release any inonies to received by it, or apply the same on any industredness secured hereby or apply the same to the restoration of the property, as it may elect. Grantor agrees to execute such further assignments of any compensation, award, damages, rights of action and proceeds as Beneficiary or Trustee may equire.
- 17. By accepting payment of any sum secured hereby after its due, late, Beneficiary does not waive its right either to require prompt payment when due of all other sums so secured or to declary default for failure so to pay.
- 18. At any time upon written request of Beneficiary, payment of its fees and presentation of this Deed and the note for endorsement (in case of full recombyance, for cancellation and retention), without affecting the liability of any person for the payment of the indebtedness Tristee may (2) consent to the making of any map or plat of said property; (b) join in granting any easement of creating any bestriction thereon; (c) join in any subordination or other agreement affecting this Deed or the lien of charge thereof; (d)-reconvey, without warranty, all or any part of the property. The Grantee in any reconveyance may be described as the "parson or persons legally entitled thereto", and the recitals therein of any matters or facts shall be conclusive proof of the truthlyliness thereof.
- 19: The collection of rents, issues, and profits, or the proceeds of fire and other insurance policies or compensation or awards for any taking or damage of the property, and the application or release thereof as aforesaid, shall not cure or waive any default or notice of default hereunder or invalidate any act done pursuant to such notice.
- 20. The Grantor covenants and agreed that he will not execute or file for record any instrument which imposes a restriction upon the sale or occupancy of the secured property on the basis of race, color, or creed. Upon any violation of this undertaking, the Beneficiary may, at its option, declare the unpaid balance of the debt secured hereby immediately due and payable.
- 21. Upon default by Grantor in payment of any indebtedness secured hereby of in performance of any agreement hereunder, Beneficiary may declare all sums secured hereby immediately due and payable. No waiver by Beneficiary of any default on the part of Grantor shall be construed as a waiver of any subsequent default hereunder.
- 22. Upon default by Grantor in the payment of any indebledness secured hereby on in the performance of any agreement contained herein, all sums secured hereby shall immediately become due and payable at the option of the Beneficiary, in such eyent and upon written request, of Beneficiary, "Inside shall soil the trust property, in accordance with the Dued of Trust Act of the State of Washington, at public auction to the highest bidder. Trustee's deed shall reclie the facts showing that the sale was conducted in compliance with all the requirements of law and of this Deed of Trust, which recital shall be prima facte evidence of such compliance and conclusive evidence thereof in favor of bona fide purchasers and encumbrancers for value. The power of sale conferred by this Deed of Trust are of the State of Washington is not an exclusive remedy and when not exercised, Beneficiary may forcefose this Deed of Trust as a mortgage.
