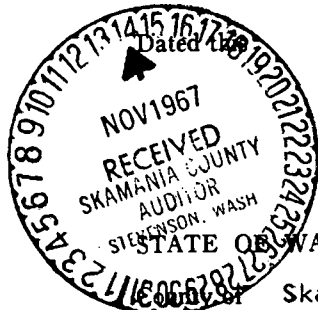
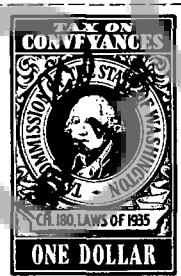
in hand paid, conveys and warrants to MEL E. STEWART and VERA M. STEWART, husband and wife,
