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## AFFIDAVIT

ELAINE M. HAUSSMAN, being first duly sworn on her oath deposes and states:

That affiant Elaine M. Haussman is the surviving widow of Henry G. Haussman who died on September 9, 1966, and that said decedent was a permanent resident of Skamania County, State of Washington, at the time of his death. That affiant and decedent executed a Community Property Agreement as provided by the statutes of the State of Washington bearing date of April 20, 1965, which instrument is recorded under auditor's file No. 65197 in Book 54 of Deeds, page 256, records of Skamania County, Washington. That said Community Property Agreement had not been amended, nulled or abrogated by the parties in any particular, and said instrument was in full force and effect in all respects at the death of decedent.

That at the time of decedent's death as aforesaid decedent and affiant owned as their community property personal property consisting of household goods and furnishings, a 1957 Ford automobile and the following described real property situated in Skamania County, State of Washington, to-wit:

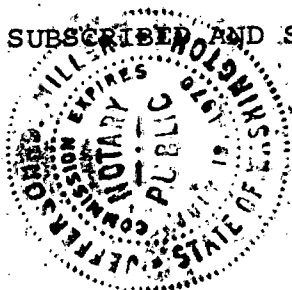
Beginning at the Southwest corner of the Northeast quarter of Section 32, Township 2 North, Range 5 East of the Willamette Meridian; thence North 483 feet; thence East 770 feet; thence South 483 feet to the quarter section line of said section; thence West along said quarter section line 770 feet to the point of beginning.

EXCEPT portion thereof lying Southeasterly of the County Road conveyed to Gerald Erickson, et ux, by deed recorded in Book 52 of Deeds, page 314 records of said County,

That decedent had no separate estate, and that all estate of decedent of every kind or nature, including jointly established accounts and including specifically the above described real and personal property did not exceed in market value the sum of \$15,000.00 at decedent's death. That decedent left a widow and three children surviving him, and that the gross estate of decedent is therefore substantially less than the applicable Washington State Inheritance Tax exemptions. That any and all debts and obligations of decedent and of their marital community have been fully paid, including decedent's funeral expenses and expenses of his last illness. That affiant makes this affidavit for the purpose of establishing her title to the entire estate of decedent, including the above described real property free of the claims of any person whomsoever.
