## COMMUNITY PROPERTY AGREEMENT

JONES and VERA WALLIN JONES, as husband and wife, all separate property now owned or hereafter acquired by the said VERA WALLIN JONES, and

The parties hereto agree that upon the death of either, title to all of their property, real, personal or mixed, shall vest in the survivor without the intervention of any Court, under the terms and provisions of Section 26.16.120 of the Revised Code of the State of Washington.
