

QUIT CLAIM DEED

THE GRANTORS PETER A. PETERSON and LYNN M.

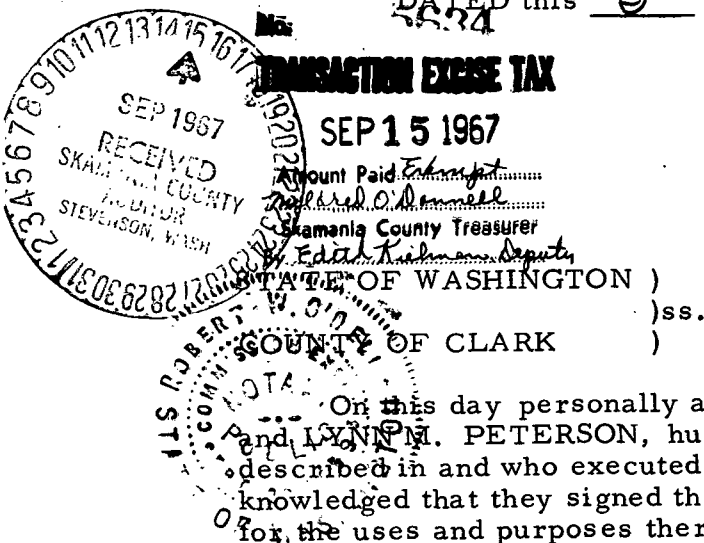
PETERSON, husband and wife, for and in consideration of One Dollar conveys and quit claims to DIANE J. TAYLOR BONNETTE, a married woman dealing with her sole and separate property, the following described real estate, situated in the County of Skamania, State of Washington:

Commencing at the Southeast corner of the homestead heretofore set apart by order of Court for the use of Mrs. Catherine Haffey and her minor child, and running thence East along the south line of the real estate belonging to the estate of William Haffey, deceased, 80 rods and 16 links to the Southeast corner of said real estate belonging to said estate; thence North along the East line of said real estate belonging to said estate 39 rods 9 links; thence West 20°30' 80 rods 16 links to the East line of said homestead 39 rods 9 links to place of beginning, containing 20 acres more or less, in Section Four (4), Township One (1) North, Range Five (5) East of the Willamette Meridian, Skamania County, Washington.

ALSO: Commencing at a point on the Northeast corner of a portion of land owned by Bernard A. Haffey (said post being on the East line of the real estate of the estate of William Haffey, deceased, 39 rods 9 links North of the Southeast corner of said estate), thence North along the East line of the Estate of William Haffey, deceased, 15 rods 17 links; thence West parallel with the North line of the real estate owned by Bernard A. Haffey 80 rods 16 links; thence South 15 rods and 17 links to the Northwest corner of that portion of real estate owned by Bernard A. Haffey; thence East along the North line of that portion of real estate owned by Bernard A. Haffey 80 rods and 16 links to the place of beginning. Containing 8 acres more or less, in Section Four (4), Township One (1) North, Range Five (5) East of the Willamette Meridian, Skamania County, Washington.
