

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this Eleventh day of October 1951, by and between Lester J. Ott and Anna C. Ott, husband and wife, residing at Carson, Washington,

Witnesseth: That whereas said Lester J. Ott and Anna C. Ott survives, the whole of the said property now owned or hereafter acquired shall at once vest in fee simple in the said Anna C. Ott And in the event of the death of the said Anna C. Ott while the said Lester J. Ott survives, the whole of said peroperty now owned or hereafter acquired shall at once vest in fee simple in Lester J. Ott.
