

## EASEMENT AND DEDICATION OF PUBLIC ROAD

The Grantors, JOHN G. ALLINGER and DOROTHY E. ALLINGER, husband and wife, for and in consideration of One Dollar in hand paid, hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey to the COUNTY OF SKAMANIA, a subdivision of the State of Washington, an easement for a public road and do hereby give and dedicate to the public forever a public road on, over and across the following described real property located in Skamania County, State of Washington:

A strip of land 24 feet in width and 674.52 feet in length together with a turn-around area (cul-de-sac), all as more particularly shown on the plat of Evergreen Acres according to the official plat thereof on file and of record at page 142 of Book A of Plats, Records of Skamania County, Washington; said real property being the south 24 feet of a tract of land in the West Half of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter ( $W\frac{1}{2}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 21, Township 3 North, Range 8 E. W. M., acquired by the grantors from Ernest F. Metzger and Louise M. Bennett by deed dated October 18, 1966, and recorded January 23, 1968, at page 339 of Book 58 of Deeds, under Auditor's File Number 69524, Records of Skamania County, Washington.

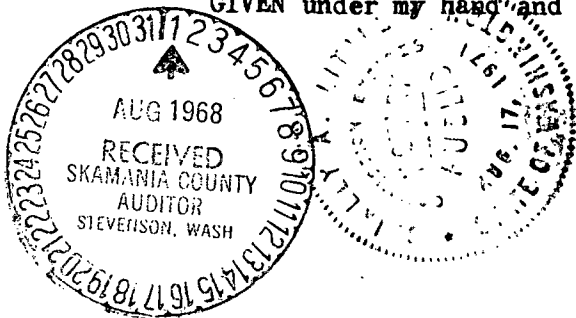
