as purchaser for the sale and purchase of the above described real estate. The grantee hereby assumes and agrees to fulfill the conditions of said real estate contract.

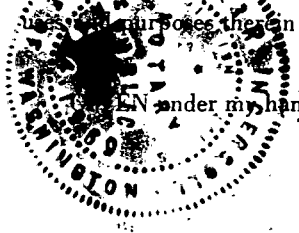
