Beginning at a point 1,052 feet south and 915.68 feet west of the northeast corner of Section 21, Township 2 North, Range 7 E. W. M.; thence north 00° 48' west 200 feet; thence north 79° 51' west 288.37 feet to the initial point of the tract hereby described; thence north 79° 51' west 20 feet; thence south 37° 02' east 27.92 feet; thence north 21° 45' east 20 feet to the initial point; said tract being located in the northeast corner of Lot 16 of Block Ten of the unrecorded plat of the Town of North Bonneville, Washington.


