### CABIN SITE LEASE

#### SECTION 1. OCCUPANCY

1.02 Master Lease. Lessor holds the above-described premises under a lease, hereinafter referred to as the "master leave," dated August 11, 1970, from the State of Washington, acting by and through the Department of Natural Resources.

1.03 Master Lease Incorporated. The master lease is on file with Lessor and is available for inspection. Lessee's rights bereunder are sub-ject to all the terms, provisions, exerptions and reservations set forth in said master lease last to which Lessee is a sub-jessue and incorporated herein by reference, including, without limiting the foregoing an easement-for right of way for on access road acquired by the United States of America, United States Forest Service and the right of the State of Washington to inspect the premises at reasonable times.

#### SECTION 2. RENTAL

2.01 Basic Rental. As rental for each lease year, the Lessee shall pay the sum of FOUR HUNDRAD & no/100

2.02 R int Adjustments. Lessor may, as of any anniversary date, increase the annual rental as follows:

### SECTION 3. LESSOR'S CONVENANTS

3.01 Declaration. In order to preserve the natural beauty of the North Woods, to provide for the control of su, others affected thereon, improvements to be made thereon, and for the purpose of extending to the residents therein the greatest a desired thereon, improvements to be made thereon, and for the purpose of extending to the residents therein the greatest and property values, Lessor does hereby certify and ideclare that with the sole exception of lot 19, which is the North Woods Sales Office, the following testivations, coverious, agreements and restrictions shall become and are hereby made a part of all leases of property within the plat of the North Woods as the same appears on the map survey recorded in the office of the County Auditor of Skemalia County, Was lington.

Lesser shall construct a boat dock for the common use of residents or the North Woods in the event construction of said boat dock is not completed by September 1, 1972, it is hereby agreed to at in lieu of such construction. Less is shall contribute \$5.000.00 to the North Woods Association, here pafter described in paragraph 5.09, reconstituction of such dock.

## SECTION 4. USE OF SITE

4.01 Parmitted Use. The cabin site shall be used only for residential purposes. No building shall be erected, altered, plated, or permitted to remain on the cabin site other than one detached single family dwelling and buildings incidental to residential use, and the cabin site shall not be further subdivided into building lots.

4)12 Condition of Site. The premises hereby leased have been inspected by Lessee and are accepted in Their freeing sondition.

4.13. Vehicles. No vehicles shall be parked in roadways. Vehicles shall not be operated carelessly or in excess of posted spuids. No vehicle shall be operated at any time without a muffler in good working order. Excessive motor noise or annoying smoke are forbidden.

A.IIA Maintenance. 'Il lots shall at all times be kept in a clean, sightly, and wholesome condition and no train, garbage, litter, junk, boxes, containers, bottles, cans, machinery, implements, lumber, or other building materials shall be permitted to be or remain exposed on any lot and visible from any street or adjoining or nearby premise.

4.06 Signs. No sit wot any kind shall he displayed to the public view on any lot in the tract except one tyrofessional sign, of not more than 18 inches by 24 inches in size, advertising the property for sale or rent, and except signs used by a builder or developer to advertise the property during the construction and sales period.

A.G. Notsance. No noxious or offensive trade to activity shall be carried on or upon any lot in the trace not shall envishing be done thereon which may be or become an annoyance or nuisance in the area.

### SECTION 6. UTILITIES

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#### SECTION 5. IMPROVEMENTS continued

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4.07 Animals. No animals, livestock, or poultry of any kind shall be raised, bred, or kept on any lot, except that cats, dogs, or other household pets may be kept, but not for any commercial purpose. Household pets shall not be allowed to become an annoyance or nuisance to the neighborhood.

4.08 Incineration. Because of unpleasant odors and unsightliness, no individual incinerator will be permitted on any lot.

4.09 Fires and Fireplaces. Interior fireplaces, stoves, or other type burner must be fireproofed by use of sparkproof screens. All fires must be extinguished before leaving cabin. No fires shall be lit or maintained outside of any cabin.

4.10 Firearms and Fireworks. Discharging firearms, firecrackers, rockets or any other fireworks within e North Woods area shall be prohibited.

4.11 Commercial Use. No platted lot shall be used for any commercial purpose, except that a Lessegal may rent his cabin from time to time, and in such case shall be responsible that his tenants abide by these covenants.

4.12 Motorbikes. No motorbike or motorcycle riding of any nature shall be allowed except for

4.13 Fire Extinguisher. One fire extinguisher (minimum two quart capacity) must be kept in every cabin.

4.14 Trailers and Tents. No tent, house trailer, or mobile home, whether the same be on wheels or not, shall be permitted on any lot except during the period of cabin construction and for guests over a weekend period.

4.15 Solicitation. There shall be no solicitation or distribution of handbills or circulation of any kind without the written consent of Lesson.

4.16 Hose Bibs. One hose bib shall be installed on outside wall of each cabin for fire protection on or before completion of the cabin.

#### **SECTION 5. IMPROVEMENTS**

5.01 Plans Approved. No building shall be erected, placed, or altered on the cabin site until the construction plans showing the location of the structure have been approved by the Lessor as to conformity with plan of development, quality of workmanship and materials, harmony of external design and color with existing structures, and as to location with respect to topography and finish grade elevation. Such approval shall be in writing.

5.02 Building Materials. All building construction shall be of log or wood frame. Wood frame stucco or simulated brick veneer construction is expressly prohibited. All roofs shall be of wood shingle or shale, or of an acceptable composition — color to be approved prior to application by the Lessor or such person or persons designated by Lessor.

5.03 Completion. Cabins must be completed from all outward appearance within one (1) year from the time such construction is started. Cabin construction must be started within three years from the date of the signing of Cabin Site Lease

5.04 Tree Removal. The Lessee of each cabin site may remove from said site all trees, shrubs, and foliage

necessary to prepare the property for huilding subject to the following conditions:

As required by the State of Washington in the master lease, any tree whose diameter is over 8" at chest height must be marked by Lessee for Lessor's inspection. Lessor will then notify the Washington State Department of Netwal Resources and request their standard appraisal of value. Lessee will then pay Lesser for the value of the tree before removal. Any additional clearing beyond that necessary for the construction of an provements shall be prohibited. The intent is to remove as few trees as possible to the end that the community remain natural and rustic.

5.05 Lot Markers. Lessee will use all reasonable care to make certain that the lot markers, as established by Lessor are not moved or de troyed.

5.06 Improvements Other Than On Cabin Site. No improvements of any kind shall be constructed or placed upon any area covered by the master lease without Lessor's prior written consent.

5.07 Ownership of Improvements. The master lease provides as follows:

"8.04 Ownership of Sub-lessee Improvements. All buildings and improvements, excluding "8.04 Ownership of Sub-lessee Improvements. All buildings and improvements, excluding removable personal property and trade fixtures on the leased site [North Woods] erected by Sub-lessee Ler see herein] will remain on said site the expiration of this lease [master lease] or termination prior to the term of this lease [master lease] of any sub-lease [this lease] held by the State under the provisions of paragraph 5.09; provided, however, upon the expiration of the lease [master lease], if the State is unsuccessful in re-leasing the leased site [North Woods], as a unit, then each sub-lease (Leasee herein] shall have a preferential right as allowed by law to re-lease from the State its sub-leased area; provided, further, upon the termination or expiration of this lease [leaset] or a sub-lease [this lease] assigned under paragraph 5.09 that as a condition of any re-lease of the leased site or sub-leased site to any other party made during the three year period following the State shall req: a the subsequent Lessee to purchase the Sub-leasee's [Lease herein] interest in the improvements as allowed by law. Expiration, as used in this paragraph, shall mean the expiration of the lease as of May 31, 2025."

The parties hereto agree that the terms and conditions of the above quoted paragraph shall be applicable provided:

(a) That Lessee is not in default under any of the terms and conditions of this lease; and (b) That Lessee's less expires May 31, 2025, in the cent of earlier expiration of this lesse, all buildings and improvements located upon the premises shall be the property of Lessor.

The parties hereto further agree that the benefits of paragraph 8.04 of the master lease shall be enforceable solely against the State of Washington.

5.08 Taxes and Assessments. The Lesses shall pay in annual payments all taxes and assessments that are now charged or may become chargeable egainst the improvements placed upon the cable site, now or in the future, come mencing with the taxes first becoming due and payable after the date hereof, all before such taxes and assessments become

5.09 North Woods Association. The roads in the plat and certain other common areas shall be hold in the name of The North Woods Association, a non-profit association, of which the Lessees of lots in the plat shall be members. Said Association shall be responsible for the maintenance and repair of roads, the entire water system including but not limited to water systems serving the cabins on the premises, docks and common areas and improvements thereon (if any), as well as other community functions which may be given it by its neuritoris. The owners (Lessees) of lots in the tract shall be required to pay dues of not less than one and one-half dollars (1½) per month and association. Said dues shall commence at the time 50 lots are lessed. It is understood and agreed that Lessor shall and it is hereby delegated to drill all duttes, responsibilities and functions of the North Woods Association until fifty (50) lots in the North Woods are lessed. At that time Lessor shall call a meeting of all Lessees for the purpose of forming said Association.

#### SECTION 6. UTILITIES

6.01 Sewage, Individual sewage dispose systems installed by Lessee must be designed, located, and constructed in accordance with the legal regulations, laws and or linances of Skamania County and the State of Washington.

6,02 Reservation. Lessor reserves to itself and to its successors and assigns easements in, under, and along all roads and other common areas in the plat for any utilities whether presently installed on no. In addition, an easement is reserved in an area five (5) feet by ten (10) feet in one corner of each of (to be selected by Lessor) adjoining the road, for electric transformer vault and/or telephone and power service pedestals if any. And the assignment of the lease as to each individual lot shall be subject to the right to cross over or under the same along the lot lines, with utility lines if such may be necessary in the development of this subdivision or adjoining subdivisions.

6.03 Water. Each cabin site has or will be furnished water at or near the lot line. Each lessee agreys to receive water from the water system supplying the North Woods and further agrees to pay Lessor \$225.00 for the right to connect to said system.

6.04 Maintenance. The lessee shall bear the responsibility and expense of furnishing, installing, backfilling, and maintaining each underground trench or other digging upon such cabin site which is necessary for any utility connections or facilities to serve such cabin site.

#### **SECTION 7. MISCELLANEOUS**

7.01 Lessee's Duties. Lessee agrees to comply strictly with the Lessor's rules and regulations and all applicable Federal, State, County, and Municipal laws, rules and regulations relating to all activities contemplated under this lesse, including but not limited to, use of public or private roads, parking, fire and prevention of fire, public health, and pollution of streams or takes, and to assume all obligations thereby imposed upon the Lessor. Lessor may inspect the cabin site and cabin at any time to determine compliance with the terms of this lease.

7.02 Indemnification. Lessee hereby agrees to assume all risk of, and indemnify and hold harmless, and at the Lessee's expense, defend the Lessor from and against, any claims, loss, cost, legal actions, liability or expense on account of personal injury to or death of any persons whomsoever, including but not limited to employees of the Lesson or dam se to or destruction of property to whomsoever belonging, including but not limited to property of the Lessor which might result from Lessee's activities on the leased premises. The Lessee further agrees to indemnify and save harmless the Lessor from any loss, cost, suit or expanse resulting from Lessee's failurn to comply with any of the provisions of any applicable laws, rules or regulations.

7.03 Insurance. Lessee shall obtain fire, casualty and liability insurance as follows:

(a) Fire and casualty insurance in a sufficient amount to cover the replacement cost of any or all improvements upon the leased premises. Such insurance shall be carried by a responsible company or companies setisfactory to Lessor and the policy or policies shall be endorsed and delivered to Lessor with provision for thirty (30) days notice of concultation to Lev. or.

b) Liability and property insurance insuring Lessor and Lessee against all liability for damages to persons or prop. ty caused by the maintenance, use or occupancy of the leased premises or by reason of the conduct of any activity carried on therein. Such insurance shall be carried by a responsible company or companies satisfactory to Lessor in amounts not less than the following limits, namely

Bodily injury to or reath of any one person, \$5,000.00; Bodily injury or death resulting from any one accident to two or more persons, \$10,000.00; and property damage, \$1,000.00.

Lessee shall deliver to Lessor certificates and receipts evidencing said policies of insurance and further provide with the company or companies for thirty (30) days' notice of cancellation to Lessor.

7,04 Assignment. Without the prior written consent of Lessor, Lessee shall not assign this lease or any interest therein, or subjet, and no heir, executor, administrator, receiver, trustee in bankruptcy or other assignee by operation of law shall assign or sublease without such written consent.

7.05 Walver. Any waiver by the Lessor of any provisions hereof must be in writing, and any of the cover ants, conditions, restrictions, in this lease may be annulled, waived, changed, or modified with respect to all or any portion of said property by Lessor at any time.

7.06 Attorneys' Fees. In the event any action, suit, proceeding or appeal therefrom is brought to collect the rent due of to become due hereunder, or any portion thereof, or to get possession of said premises, or to enforce complaince with this fease, or for failure to observe any of the covenants of this lease, the prevailing party shall be entitled to recover such sum as the Court may adjudge reasonable as attorner: "fees to be allowed in said suit, action, proceeding or repeal therefrom in addition to such other relief granted by the source."

7.67 Condemnation. The parties hereto shall receive any sums or damages paid or awarded by reason of any taking condemnation or acquisition during the existence of this lease as their interests therein shall then appear, whether or not by litigation, by any authority, person or corporation, whether public or private, of any title to or interest in all or any part of the prem

7,08 Reservoir Level. The Lessee acknowledges by signing this lease that Pacific Power and Light Company has the right to fluctuate the waters of Swift Reservoir at any time within the provisions of Federal Power Com-mission License No. 2111 or as amended. 8.02 Master Lease Termination. It is expressly understood that Lessor has leased the premises from the State of Washington for a period ending June 1, 2025. The master lease provides that in the event it is terminated for any reason whatsoever, prior to the lease termination date, such termination shall operate as an assignment to the State of Washington of this lease together with the unrestricted right of the State to receive payment of the rents herein provided from the date of said assignment.

8.03 Failure to Provide Property Report. Lessee shall have the option to void this lease if he does not receive a property report prepared pursuant to the rules and regulations of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, in advance of, or at the time of, his signing the lease, and Lessee shall have the right to revoke this lease within 48 hours after signing the lease if he did not receive the property report at least 48 hours before signing the lease. However, this option to void the lease shall not apply where Lessee has recrived the property report and inspected the lot or lots to be leased in advance of signing the lease and acknowledges by his signature that he has made such inspection and has read and understands such report.

Each and every provision of this lease shall bind and shall inure to the benefit of the respective heirs, representatives, successors and assigns of the parties. In the event lessee is more than one person, the liability of such persons hereunder shall be joint and several.

# AGREEMENT

This AGREEMENT, made and entered into on this 20 day of Figures, 1975, by and between the UNITED STATES OF MERICA, acting through the Bonneville Power Administrator, as authorized by 16 U.S.C. 832, et seq., hereinafter called the Government, and the COUNTY OF SKANAMIA, STATE OF LASHINGTON, acting by and through its County Commissioners, hereinafter called the County,

## WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS the County has acquired the ownership of a right-of-way for the improvement of County Road No. 2027 (Ryan Allen Road), over and across the following described tracts of land:

which right-of-way is in part located on property acquired by the Government for a right-of-way for the Bonneville Power Administration Bonneville-Coulee No. 1 (operated as Underwood Tap) and Bonneville-Coulee No. 2 (operated as North Bonneville-Midway No. 1) electric power transmission lines, between structures identific as UNDW TAP 1-5-2 and 1-5-4 and NBON MID 1-5-3 and 1-5-5, in accordance with County's drawing entitled "RYAN ALLEN ROAD CO. RD. NO. 20380", Sheets A1.35 and B1.35, C.R.P. No. 77-26 a copy of each of which is on file with the Branch of Land, BPA, Portland, Oregon; and

WHEREAS it is the desire of the said parties to adjust and modify the respective rights of said parties to permit the crossing of the Government's rights-of-way with a minimum of conflict;

#### IT IS THEREFORE AGREED:

- 1. That the County will pay the Government the cost of any relocation of electric power transmission line structures within the boundaries of the Government's rights-of-way at and adjacent to such crossings as the County may request.
- 2. That any and all damage or injury to the Government's property caused by or resulting from the construction or repair of the County's crossing or facilities may be repaired by the Government and the actual costs of such repair be charged against and paid by the County.
- 3. That the Government reserves the right to erect, construct, and maintain the conductors (wires) of the existing and future electric power transmission line or lines over said road right of way in such manner as Will not interfere with or endanger the use of said right-of-way for public road purposes, as said road is now proposed to be located and used.
- 4. That the County will provide the Government with approaches to existing towers NBON MID 1=5=4 and UNDW TAP 1-5=3, opposite County station 41+75 $\pm$ ; at no expense to the Government.
- 5. Should any rights acquired by the County by this agreement no lenger be used or needed for public road purposes, such rights granted shall terminate and revert to and revest in the Government.
- 6. This Agreement is subject to the rights hereto. Fe granted to the owners of the adjoining land in said NEWSF4 and SEWNEY of Section 35 for the use of said property for ingress and egress and for agricultural and other purposes by easement deeds dated November 7, 1939, September 3, 1940, and August 8, 1941.

The County covenants a pagrees that it will comply with the terms and provisions of Title VI of the Sizil Rights Act of 1964 / 78 Stats 241; to the extent that the provisions of said Act apply to the County. In the eyent of violations, the Government reserves the right to invoke the provisions of Section 17.4 of Title 43 G.F.R.
