NOTICE OF LIS PENDENS


NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that an action has been commenced in the Superior Court of the State of Washington in and for Skamania County, by the above named plaintiffs and against the above named defendants and which action is now pending in said Court and that the purpose and objection of said action is to secure an order of the above-entitled Court forever enjoining and restraining the defendants from entering into, trespassing upon, damaging in any manner or interfering in any manner with the plaintiffs possession of the following described real property, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the Southerly line of the Evergreen Highway which point is South 1257 feet and West 38.93 feet from the common corner of Section 15, 16, 21, and 22 in Township 2 North, Range 7 E.W.M., and running thence South 90° 00' West 160 feet; thence North 81° 00' West 851.9 feet; thence North 79° 51' West 226.9 feet to the true point of beginning of the tract herein described; and running thence North 79° 51' West 97 feet; thence South 10° 09' West 10 feet, more or less to the Northerly line of the Spokane, Portland & Seattle Railway right-of-way; thence South 71° 40' East 98 feet; and thence North 10° 09' East 23.8 feet, more or less, to the place of beginning, being described as a portion of Lot 10 in Block 5, of the unrecorded plat of the Town of North Bonneville, Skamania County, Washington.
