REAL ESTATE CONTRACT

THIS CONTRACT, made and entered into this

21st day of

March, 1969,

between MILDRED M. O'DONNELL, dealing with her separate property,

hereinafter called the "seller," and GEORGE W. JEAN and BILLIE B. JEAN, husband and wife,

hereinafter called the "purchaser,"

WITNESSETH: That the seller agrees to sell to the purchaser and the purchaser agrees to purchase from the seller the following described real estate, with the appurtenances, in **Skamania** County, State of Washington:

A tract of land located in Government Lots 2 and 3 of Section 6, Township 1 North, Range 6 E. W. M., more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point 1,320 feet east and 914 feet south of the quarter corner on the west line of the said Section 6; thence north 54° 35° east 120.3 feet; thence north 71° 09° east 161.7 feet; thence north 52° 48° east 863.6 feet; thence east 155.6 feet; thence north 62° 05° east 227.8 feet; thence south 24° 45° east 228.3 feet; thence south 13° 40° east 435 feet to meander line of the Columbia River; thence westerly along said meander line to a point south of the point of beginning; thence north 498 feet to the point of beginning; EXCEPT that portion thereof lying southerly of the northerly line of the Spokane, Portland and Seattle Railway Company's right of way; AND EXCEPT that portion thereof lying within and northerly of the right of way acquired by the State of Washington for Primary State Highway No. 8. EXCEPT a tract of the approximate size of 100 feet by 100 feet on the east end of said property reserved by the seller together with access for an approach road and utilities as set forth in an earnest money agreement between the parties.

The terms and conditions of this contract are as follows: The purchase price is Thirty Thousand and no/100ths - - (\$ 30,000.00) Dollars, of which been paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and the balance of said purchase price shall be paid as follows:

The remaining balance of the purchase price amounting to \$25,000.00 shall be paid by the purchasers as follows: (a) By the purchasers assuming and paying in accordance with the terms and conditions thereof a mortgage given by the seller to the Columbia Gorge Bank at Stevenson, Washington, to secure a promissory note dated March 1, 1969, on which there remains unpaid the principal sum of approximately \$12,000.00; and (b) by paying to the seller the remaining balance of the purchase price amounting to approximately \$13,000.00 as follows: The sum of \$5,000.00, or more, on April 1, 1970; the further sum of \$5,000.00, or more, on April 1, 1971; and the remaining balance of the purchase price on April 1, 1972; said installments to include interest on the diminishing principal basis at the rate of 4% per annum payable annually.

The seller shall have the privilege of remaining in possession and occupying the dwelling house on said premises until April 5, 1971, and the seller shall pay general taxes for 1969 and shall keep and maintain fire insurance on the aforesaid dwelling house to and including April 5, 1971.

- (1) The purchaser assumes and agrees to pay before delinquency all taxes and assessments that may as between grantor and grantee hereafter become a lien on said real estate; and if by the terms of this contract the purchaser has assumed payment of any mortgage, contract or other encumbrance, or has assumed payment of or agreed to purchase subject to, any taxes or assessments now a lien on said real estate, the purchaser agrees to pay the same before delinquency.
- (2) The purchaser agrees, until the purchase price is fully paid, to keep the buildings now and hereafter placed on said real estate insured to the actual cash value thereof against loss or damage by both fire and windstorm in a company acceptable to the seller and for the seller's benefit, as his interest may appear, and to pay all premiums therefor and to deliver all policies and renewals thereof to the seller.
- (3) The purchaser agrees that full inspection of said real estate has been made and that neither the seller nor his assigns shall be held to any covenant respecting the condition of any improvements thereon nor shall the purchaser or seller or the assigns of either be held to any covenant or agreement for alterations, improvements or repairs unless the covenant or agreement relied on is contained herein or is in writing and attached to and made a part of this contract.

 (4) The purchaser assumes all hazards of damage to or destruction of any improvements now on said real estate or hereafter placed thereon, and of the taking of said real estate or any part thereof for public use; and agrees that no such damage, destruction or taking shall constitute a failure of consideration. In case any part thereof for public use; and agrees that no such damage, destruction or taking shall remaining after payment of reasonable expenses of procuring the same shall be paid to the seller and applied as payment on the purchase, price herein unless the seller elects to allow the purchaser to apply all or a portion of such condemnation award to the rebuilding or restoration of any improvements damaged by such taking. In case of damage or destruction from a peril insured against, the proceeds of such insurance remaining after payment of the reasonable expense of procuring the same shall be devoted to the restoration or rebuilding of such improvements within a reasonable time, unless purchaser elects that said proceeds shall be paid to the seller for application on the purchase price herein.
- (5) The seller has delivered, or agrees to deliver within 15 days of the date of closing, a purchaser's policy of title insurance in standard form, or a commitment therefor, issued by Transamerica Title Insurance Company, insuring the purchaser to the full amount of said purchase price against loss or damage by reason of defect in seller's title to said real estate as of the date of closing and containing no exceptions other than the following:
 - a. Printed general exceptions appearing in said policy form;
 - b. Liens or encumbrances which by the terms of this contract the purchaser is to assume, or as to which the conveyance hereunder is to be made subject; and
 - c. Any existing contract or contracts under which seller is purchasing said real estate, and any mortgage or other obligation, which seller by this contract agrees to pay, none of which for the purpose of this paragraph (5) shall be deemed defects in seller's title.
