

CORRECTIVE DEED

THIS INDENTURE Made and entered into this 18
day of JUNE 1969, by and between the State Forest
Board and the Department of Natural Resources, of the State
of Washington, party of the first part, and William Edgar
Dame, party of the second part, Witnesseth:

WHEREAS, on the 5th day of October 1937, the Board
of Commissioners of Skamania County, conveyed to the State
of Washington certain real property acquired by said county
through tax foreclosure, to be administered by the State
Forest Board as provided by law, which said deed is recorded
at page 532, book ² 3 of Deeds, records of said county, refer-
ence to which is hereby made; and

WHEREAS, there is included in said deed the following
parcel, to-wit:

The Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter
(SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 12, Township 3 North,
Range 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ East, W.M.,

which said parcel of land had theretofore been sold by the
Treasurer of Skamania County to William Edgar Dame; and

WHEREAS, it was not intended by said deed to convey
said parcel, and

WHEREAS, said parcel was included by mistake,


NOW, THEREFORE, in order to vest in William Edgar
Dame and to remove cloud from the title to the property
inadvertently included in said deed to the present owner
thereof, the party of the first part does hereby convey
unto the party of the second part the following real property
in Skamania County, Washington, to-wit:

The Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter
(SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 12, Township 3 North,
Range 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ East, W.M.

to have and to hold unto the party of the second part in
fee simple.

This deed is executed and delivered pursuant to the
authority of and at the request of the Commissioner of
Public Lands.
