

DECLARATION OF HOMESTEAD

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That I, CARL J. ARNOLD, do hereby certify and declare as follows, to-wit:

1. That I am the head of the family, I am married and my wife's name is JEAN ARNOLD;

2. That I am now residing with my family on the premises hereinafter described, consisting of land and the dwelling house thereon;

3. That I claim the premises, hereinafter described, as a homestead;

4. That there exists against the premises hereinafter described, the following mortgage, to-wit: Columbia Gorge Bank - unpaid balance amounting to \$14,000.00;


5. That I estimate the actual cash value of my interest in the premises hereinafter described to be \$4,500.00;

SUBJECT to restrictive covenants of record and an easement to the Town of Stevenson for a municipal water pipeline.


