The purchasers have applied to the Washington State Liquor Control Board for the transfer of the license hold by the sellers, and it is agreed and understood that this contract shall be contingent upon the approval of the purchasers' application and the transfer of said license by the Washington State Liquor Control Board.
- S. Remedies of sellers in case of default. Time is of the assence of this contract, and it is agreed that in case the purchasers shall fail to comply with or perform any condition or agreement hereof or to make any payment required hereunder promptly at the time and in the menner herein required, the sellers may elect to declare all the purchasers! rights hereunder terminated, and upon their doing so, all payments made by the purchasers hereunder shall be forfeited to the sellers as liquidated damagas, and the sellers shall have the right to re-enter and take possession of the subject matter of this contract; and no waiver by the sellers of any default on the part of the purchasers shall be construed as a waiver of any subsequent default. The purchasers further agree to give to sallers a security interest in the subject

matter of this contract under the Uniform Commercial Code of the State of Washington, and the sellers reserve to themselves and their agents the right to pursue all remedies available to them as a secured party under the Uniform Commercial Code aforesaid.

- The purchasers duty to comply with health regulations and local ordinances.

  The purchasers agree in conduct of the tovern business aforesaid to comply with all rules and regulations of the State Department of Health and all applicable ordinances of the County of Skamania.
- 7. Warranty Deed and Bill of Sale. When the purchasers shall have paid the purchase price in full together with interest, sellers agree to deliver a statutory warranty deed and bill of sale to the premises described in paragraph 1 above, together with an owner\*s policy of title insurance in the sum of \$10,500.00.
- 8. Fire Insurance. The purchasers agree to keep all improvements on said premises, and all of the trade fixtures described in paragraph 1, insured against loss by fire to their full insurable value, and to deliver to the sellers a copy of the fire insurance policy issued by a company satisfactory to the sellers; and in the event the purchasers do not obtain such fire insurance coverage the sellers reserve the right to effect the same and to add the cost thereof to the unpaid purchase price on the contract.
- 9. Mon-Assignment. This contract or any interest therein shall not be assigned or transferred by the purchasers without the express written prior consent of the sollers.
