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## REAL ESTATE CONTRACT

THIS CONTRACT, made and entered into this 15th day of October, 1970,

OTTO LOUIS SCHAUB, a widower,

MARGARETHA TORWS hereinafter called the "seller," and

hereinafter called the "purchaser,"

WITNESSETH: That the seller agrees to sell to the purchaser and the purchaser agrees to purchase from the seller the following described real estate, with the appurtenances, in Skamania County, State of Washington:

The terms and conditions of this contract are as follows: The purchase price is Twenty-two Thousand and no/100ths (\$ 22,000.00 ) Dollars, of which • Ten Thousand and no/100ths -- (\$ 10,000.00 ) Dollars have been paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and the balance of said purchase price shall be paid as follows:

The balance of the purchase price amounting to Twelve Thousand and no/100 (\$12,000.00) Dollars is to be paid as follows: \$6,000.00 plus interest at 7% per annum on or before October 15, 1971, and \$6,000.00 plus interest at 7% per annum on or before October 15, 1972. The purchaser reserves the right at any time she is not in default under the terms and conditions of this contract to pay without penalty any part orall of the unpaid purchase price, plus interest then due.

All payments to be made hereunder shall be made at 325 North Hancock, Ottumwa, Iowa 5250 or at such other place as the seller may direct in writing.

The purchaser assumes and agrees to pay before delinquency all taxes and as essments that may as between granter and granter here are become a lien on said real estate; and it by the terms of this contract the purchaser has assumed payment of any mor gage, contract or other entimbrance, or has assumed payment of or agreed to purchase subject to, any taxes or assessments now a lien on said real estate, the purchaser agrees to pay the same before delinquency.

(2) The purchaser agrees, until the purchase price is fully paid, to keep the bui-lings now and hereafter placed on said real estate (insured to the actual cash value thereof against loss or damage by both fire and windstorm in a company acceptable to the seller and for the seller's benefit, as his interest may appear, and to pay all premiums therefor and to deliver all policies and renewals thereof to the seller.

(3) The purchaise agrees that full inspection of said real estate has been made and that neither the seller nor his assigns shall be held to any covenant respecting the condition of any improvements thereon nor shall the purchaser or seller or the assigns of either be held to any covenant or spreament for alterations, improvements or repairs unless the covenant or, agreement relief on is contained herein or is in writing and attached to and made a part of this contract.

(4) The purchaser assumes all hazards of damage to or destruction of any improvements now on said real estate or hereafter placed

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(5) The seller has delivered, or agrees to deliver within 15 days of the date of closing, a purchaser's policy of title insurance in standard form, or a commitment therefor, issued by Tronsociarica Title Insurance Company, insuring the purchaser to the full amount of said purchase price against loss or damage by reason of defect in seller's title to said real estate as of the date of closing and containing no exceptions other than the following:

a. Printed general exceptions appearing to said policy form;
b. Liens in incumbrance, which by the terms of this contract the purchaser is to assume, or as to which the conveyance hereunder is to be made subject; and

c. Any existing contracts or contracts under which sciler is purchasing said real estate, and any mortgage or offer obligation, which aciler by this contract agrees to pay, none of which for the purpose of this paragraph (5) shall be deemed defect; in seller's title.

(6) If seller's title to said real estato is subject to an existing contract or contracts under which seller is purchasing said real estate, or any mortgage or other obligation, which seller is to pay, seller agrees to make such payments is accordance with the terms thereof, and upon default, the purchaser shall have the right to make any payments accessary to remove the default, and any payments so made shall be applied to the payments next falling due the seller under this contract.

(7) The seller agrees, upon receiving full payment of the purchase price and interest in the manner above specified, to execute and deed to said resi estate, excepting any part thereof hereafter deliver to purchaser a statutory warranty taken for public use, free of encumbrances except any that may attach after date of closing through any person other than the seller, and subject to the following:

- (a) Easements and rights of way, if any, for electric power distribution lines: and
- (b) Restrictive covenants of record.
- (8) Unless a different date is provided for herein, the purchaser shall be entitled to possession of said real estate on date of closing and to retain possession so long as purchaser is not in default hereunder. The purchaser covenants to keep the buildings and other improvements on said real estate in good repair and not to permit waste and not to use, or permit the use of, the real estate for any illegal purpose. The purchaser covenants to pay all service, installation or construction charges for water, sewer, electricity, garbage or other utility services furnished to said real estate after the date purchaser is entitled to possession.

(9) In case the purchaser fails to make any payment herein provided or to maintain insurance, as herein required, the seller may make such payment or effect such insurance, and any amounts so paid by the seller, together with interest at the rate of 40% per annua thereon from date of payment until repaid, shall be repayable by purchaser on sellers, degether with interest at the rate of 40% per annua thereon from date of payment until repaid, shall be repayable by purchaser on sellers, demand, all without prejudice to any other right the seller might have by reason of such default.

(10) Time is of the essence of this contract, and it is agreed that in case the purchaser shall fall to comply with or perform any condition or agreement hereof or to make any payment required her under promptly at the time and in the manner herein required, the seller may elect to declare all the purchaser's rights hereunder terminated, and upon this doing so, all payments made by the purchaser hereunder and all improvements placed upon the real estate shall be 'reficied to 'reflere all indicated damages, and the seller shall have right to re-enter and take possession of the real estate; and no walver by the seller as liquidated damages, and the seller shall be construed as a waiver of any subsequent default.

Service upon purchaser of all demants, notices or other papers with respect to forfeiture and termination of purchaser's rights may be made by United States Mall, postage pre-paid, return receipt requested, directed to the purchaser at his address last known to the seller.

(11) Upon seller's election to bring sa't to enforce any covenant of this courter, including suit to collect any payment required hereunder, the purchaser agrees to pay a read stable sum as attorney's fees and all costs and expenses in connection with such suit, which, sums shall be included in any judgment or derive entered in such suit.

If the seller shall bring suit to procure an adjudication of the termination of the purchaser's rights hereunder, and judgment or entered, the purchaser agrees to pay a reasonable sum as attorney's fees and all costs and expenses in connection with such suit, and alrother reasonable cost of searching records to determine the condition of title at the date such suit is commenced, which sums shall be included in any judgment or decree entered in such suit.
