## TRANSMISSION LINE RASEMENT AND ACCESS ROAD RASEMENT

The Grantor, CEDWN ZELLERBACH CORPORATION, a Nevada corporation, recognizing that public necessity requires that the herein-described rights be made available forthwith to Grantee, notwithstanding Grantor's wish to retain same, and desiring to avoid the delays and inconvenience incident to the acquisition of such rights by eniment domain, for and in consideration of the sum of FIFTEN THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED SIXTY-WIGH POLICIES (\$15,569.00), in hand paid by the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, hereby grants, bargains, sells and conveys to the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA and its assigns, a perpetual easement and right to enter and erect, maintain, repair, rebuild, operate, and patrol one line of electric power transmission structures and appurtenant signal lines, including the right to erect such poles, transmission structures, wires, cables, and appurtenances as are necessary thereto, in, over, upon, and across the parcels of land in the County of Skamania, in the State of Washington, described in Exhibit A, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

- 1. It is agreed that any damage to Grantor's agricultural crops, fences, or irrigation or drainage systems, on the right-of-way resulting from and in the course of construction, reconstruction or maintenance of the transmission line or lines shall be repaired, replaced or paid for by the Grantee or its contractor. Where payment is made, the amount of damages will be determined by an appraisal made by the Grantee.
- 2. For the purpose of preserving the natural appearance of the right-of-way it is agreed by the Grantor and the Grantee that the right-of-way shall not be used for the accumulation or dumping of litter, trash or other foreign material. The Grantee agrees that any such accumulations resulting from its entry upon the right-of-way for construction or maintenance purposes will be removed or disposed of by Grantee or its contractor.

As part of the consideration for this grant it is agreed that the foregoing provisions numbered 1 and 2, shall hereinafter also apply to the previously existing rights-of-way on Grantor's property described in the easement recorded in Book 43, page 205, under Auditor's File No. 52050, the easement recorded in Book 37, page 480, under Auditor's File No. 46559, and the easement recorded in Book 36, page 229, under Auditor's File No. 45155, all in Dead records of Skamania County, Weshington.

The rights granted herein include the present and future right to clear said right-of-way and keep the same clear of brush, timber, structures, and fire hazards, provided that fire hazards shall not be interpreted to include any grow-hazards, provided that fire hazards shall not be interpreted to include any grow-hazards, provided that fire hazards shall not be interpreted to include any grow-hazards, and dead trees and also the present right to top, limb or fell all growing and dead trees and snags (collectively called "danger trees") located on land owned by the Grantor adjacent to the above-described right-of-way, which could fail within 35 feet of any conductor of the electric transmission facilities hereinbefore described; provided, however, it is agreed that compensation is included in the consideration stated above for trees or snags within the strips of land shown colored in greez in Exhibit B, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof, contiguous to said right-of-way that are (a) danger trees on August 20, 1970, (hereinafter called "present danger trees"). The right to top, limb or fell danger trees outside of said strips (hereinafter called "additional danger trees") may only be electised within three years after all present danger trees have been dut, and the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA shall pay the person who is the owner thorse at the date of cutting under authority of the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, such payment to be made within a reasonable period of time after they have been so cut.

In addition, the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA has the right to top, limb, fell, or remove the following (kees:

One 40-Anch in diamiter Douglas Fir, 25 feat outside of the right-of-way on the North side, opposite survey station 7289 + 50;

One 1 inch in dispeter Douglas Fir, 35 feet outside of the right-of-way on the North side, opposite survey station 7323 4 25;

One 20-inch in disreter Douglas Fir, 50 feet outside of the right-of-way on the North side, opposite survey station 7330 + 55.

It is understood and agreed that all trees growing on the right-of-way two years after initial clearing and construction of each transmission line shall become the property of the CHOWN ZELLERBACH CORFORATION and may be permitted to reach a height of 10 feet within strips of land 70 feet in width, 35 feet in width on each side of the centerline of each line of transmission structures, and 15 feet in height elsewhere on the right-of-way. If any such trees exceed these limits, the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA shall give notice of such fact in writing to CROWN ZELLERBACH CORFORATION. If any trees exceeding these limits remain for six months after such notice is given to CROWN ZELLERBACH CORFORATION, the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA shall have the right to cut said trees, or kill all trees by chemical means that are in the area where the trees exceeding these limits remain, irrespective of their height, except the Government shall not be responsible for damage to such trees during maintenance or reconstruction activities.

Grantor also hereby grants, bargains, sells, and conveys unto the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, and its assigns, a permanent easement and right-of-way for the construction, operation, use and maintenance of roads approximately 50 Heet in width in Tracts Ha-O-AR-137-3, Ha-O-AR-139-1 and Ha-O-AR-139-2, and approximately 20 fuet in width in Tracts Ha-O-AR-137-1, Parcel 2, Ha-O-AR-137-2, Parcel 1, Ha-O-AR-137-2, Parcel 2, Ha-O-AR-138-1, Parcels 1 and 2, Ha-O-AR-139-3, and Ha-O-AR-143-1, on, over, and across the lands of the Grantor in the NEWNER, the SUWNER, and SEWNW of Section 14, Township 3 North, Range 8 East, Willamette Meridian; the SUWNER, and SEWNW of Section 14, Township 3 North, Range 8 East, Willamette Meridian, and Government Lot 9 of Section 24, Township 3 North, Range 7½ East, Willamette Meridian, a'll in Skamania County, Washington, except any portion thereof lying within the Bouneville Power Administration's Hanford-Ostrander No. 1 transmission line right-of-way, for the following purposes, namely: the right to enter and to clear of timber, danger trees, and brush; to build, cut, fill, level, grade, drain, surface, use and maintain, repair and rebuild the roads and such culverts, bridges, turn-outs, retaining walls or other appurtenant structures as may be necessary, on, over, and across the land embraced within said right-of-way, as shown colored in red on drawings serially numbered 150437, 150438, 150439, and 150443 DTM-D, prepared by the United States Department of the Interior, Bonneville Power Administration, attached hereto and by this reference, made a part hereof.

The Grantor reserves the right of ingress and egress over and across said roads and the right to pass and repass along and on said roads insofar as the same extend across the lands of the Grantor, said right to be exercised in a manner that will not interfere with the use of the roads by the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, its employees, contractors or assigns.

It is understood and agreed that if said roads are draaged by the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, its employees, contractors, or assigns, the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, subject to the availability of appropriations, or its assigns, will repair such damage. It is further understood and agreed that Grantor may erect or maintain fonces across such roads, provided adequate gates of not less than 16 feet in width are installed, which may be kept locked, provided the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA is also permitted to install its own lock thereon.

The herein-described access roads may be used for ingress and egress to and from the Bonneville Power Administration's Hanford-Ostrander No. 1 transmission line and to and from any existing or future transmission lines which have been or may be constructed adjacent or nearly adjacent thereto.

The rights granted herein include all necessary and convenient access over, along and across existing roads on premises owned by the Grantor within existing Bonneville Power Administration easements.

TO HAVE AND TO MOLD said easement and rights unto the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA and its assigns, forever.

The Grantor covenants to and with the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA and its assigns that the title to all brush, timber or structures existing upon the rights-of-way on August 20, 1970, and the title to all present danger trees shall vest

in the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA on said date; and that title to any additional danger trees shall vest in the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA upon their being cut pursuant to the terms hereof; and that the consideration stated herein is accepted by the Grantor as full compensation for all damages incidental to the exercise of said casement and danger tree rights, except payment for any additional danger trees as dorined hereinabove which may be cut under sutherity of the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA as herein provided.

The Grantor also covenants to and with the JNITED TATES OF AMERICA that Grantor is lawfully seized and ponsessed of the lands and d; has a good and lawful right and power to sell and convey same; that a same free and clear of encumbrances, except as shove indicated; and that Grantor will forever warrant and defend the title to said easement and the quiet possession thereof against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomseever.
