

EASEMENT

The Grantor, CARSON LUMBER COMPANY, a Washington corporation, for and in consideration of Ten Dollars in hand paid, grants, bargains, sells and conveys to the Grantee, THE COUNTY OF SKAMANIA, a subdivision of the State of Washington, an easement and right of way 60 feet in width over and across the following described real property located in the County of Skamania, State of Washington:

A tract of land in the Murphy D. L. Co. in Section 27, Township 3 North, Range 3 E. W. M., as more particularly described in deed dated September 10, 1947, and recorded May 21, 1948, at page 47 of Book 32 of Deeds, Records of Skamania County, Washington;

The description of said easement and right of way is more particularly shown on the plat of State Road 8 in Drawer E-5-5 in the Skamania County Engineer's Office (as the same existed in December 1915.) The Grantor in particular grants to the Grantee the right to cut the grade of said easement to the level of the existing county road.
