

AFFIDAVIT OF SURVIVING SPOUSE
UNDER COMMUNITY PROPERTY AGREEMENT

VERA WALLIN JONES being first duly sworn on oath deposes and says:

That I am the surviving spouse of CHARLES J. JONES, who died on August 3, 1960, being at the time of his death a resident and inhabitant of Skamania County, State of Washington.

That CHARLES J. JONES and I, as husband and wife, made and entered into a Community Property Agreement on April 13, 1965, which said agreement was duly recorded April 15, 1965, in Volume 54 of Deeds, page 153, under Auditor's file No. 64900, records of Skamania County.

That said Community Property Agreement was never amended, altered, or changed in any form, nor revoked, and remained in full force and effect as between me and the said CHARLES J. JONES on the date of his death.

That the estate of CHARLES J. JONES consists of his community one-half interest with me in both real and personal property in Skamania County, all of which was the subject matter of said Community Property Agreement, and all expenses of last illness and of burial have been paid in full, as have all other debts, and there are no creditors having outstanding claims against the said CHARLES J. JONES, or any of his property.

That the said CHARLES J. JONES had no children, either by natural birth or by adoption, as the issue of his marriage to me, or of a prior marriage.

That no other person or persons have any right, title, or interest in and to the real and personal property which was the subject matter of said Community Property Agreement and which passed to me by its terms and provisions.
