The terms and conditions of this contract are as follows: The purchase price is Eleven Thousand and no/190ths) Dollars, of which 11,000.00 1,000.00) Dollars have One Thousand and no/100ths been paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and the balance of said purchase price shall be paid as follows:

The purchasers agree to pay the balance of the purchase price in the sum of Ten Thousand and no/100ths (\$10,000.00) Dollars in monthly installments of One Hundred and no/100ths (\$100.00) Bollars, or more, commencing on the 1st day of October, 1971, and on the 1st day of each and every month thereafter until the full amount of the purchase price together with interest shall have been paid. The purchasers reserve the right at any time they are not in default under the terms and conditions of this contract to pay without penalty any part or all of the unpaid purchase price, plus interest then due .

(1) The purchaser assumes and agrees to pay before delinquency all taxes and assessments that may as between grantor and grantee hereafter become a lien on said real estate; and it by the terms of this contract the purchaser has assumed payment of any mortgage, contract or other encumbrance, or has assumed payment of or agreed to purchase subject to, any taxes or assessments flow a lien on said real estate, the purchaser agrees to pay the same before delinquency.

The purchaser covenants to keep the buildings and other impravements on said real estate in good repair and not to permit waste and not to use, or permit the use of, the real estate for; any illegal purpose. The purchaser covenants to pay all service, installation or construction charges for water, sewer, electricity, garbage or inter utility services furnished to said real estate after the date purchaser is entitled to possession.
