A right-of-way as required for the reconstruction of the County Road known and designated Maple Way Road, County Road No. 2060, in Section 36, Township 3 North, Range 7 East, W. M., in Skamania County, Washington, more particularly described as follows:



A strip of land 60 feet in width, 30 feet westerly and 30 feet easterly of, parallel and concentric with the following-described centerline from Station 25 + 25± to Station 28 + 30 ±: Beginning at Station 3 + 65.47, an iron reinforcing bar in the intersection of Maple Way and Gropper Road, said point being it. 37° 38! W. 668.00 feet from the center of Section 55, Township 3 Worth, Range 7 East, W. M.; thence N. 3° 06! W. 612.29 feet to P. C. Station 11 + 77.76; then a on a 11° 30! curve to the left 711.88 feet; thence N. 81° 58! W. 457.02 feet to P. C. Station 23 + 45.6; thence on a 11° 30! curve to the right 725.9h feet to P. T. Station 30 + 72.60.

Reserving unto the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, and its assigns, the right to maintain existing electric transmission lines and to erect and maintain future transmission lines over and across the essement area, but without supporting structures located in the essement area.

Reserving also unto the UNITED STATES OF A.ERICA and its essigns, the right of access to and along the transmission line right-of-way.

the right to construct, operate and maintain such approaches to the Skemania County road described herein as the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA may consider necessary or convenient to the construction, operation and maintenance of its transmission lines.

It is understood and agreed that SKAMANIA COUNTY shall be liable for any damage to the property of the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, including transmission lines and structures, arising out of or resulting from acts of Skamania County's employees or agents acting within their authority in construction, reconstruction, or maintenance of said road upon the property of the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA.

Should the rights acquired by SKAMANIA COUNTY by this easement no longer be used or needed for public road purposes, all rights granted by this easement shall terminate and revert to and revest in the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the above-described and granted easement unto SKAMANIA COUNTY, and its assigns, forever.
