All that portion of the East half of the Southeast Quarter (E-1/2 SE-1/4) of Section Twenty-seven (27), Township Three (3) North, Range Nine (9) E.W.M., lying northerly of the following described line:

Beginning at a point on the east line of the said Section Twenty-seven (27) south 1,434.28 feet from the quarter corner common to Sections Twenty-six (26) and Twenty-seven (27), Township Three (3) North, Range Nine (9) E.W.M., said point being marked by an iron bar; thence north 69°04' West 1,399.49 feet to intersection with the west line of the E-1/2 of the SE-1/4 of the said Section Twenty-seven (27).
