a. Printed general exceptions appearing in said policy form;
b. Liens or encumbrances which by the terms of this contract the purchaser is to assume, or as to which the conveyance hereunder is to be made subject; and

c. Any existing contracts or contracts under which seller is purchasing said real estate, and any mortgage or other obligation, which seller by this contract agrees to pay, none of which for the purpose of this paragraph (5) shall be deemed defects in seller's title,

(6) If seller nutitle to said real estate is subject to an existing contract or contracts under which seller is purchasing axid axid erial or any mintegage or other obligation, which seller is to pay, seller agrees to make such payments in accordance with the terms thereoff are upon default, the purchaser s all have the right to make any payments necessary to remove the default, and any payments so made also be applied to the payments year falling due the seller under this contract.

(8) Unless a different date is provided for herein, the purchaser shall be entitled to possession of said real estate on date of closing and to retain possession so long as purchaser is not in default hereunder. The purchaser covenants to appail service, installation or construction charges for water, sewer, electricity, garbage or other utility services furnished to said real estate after the date purchaser is estitled to possession.

The seller may elect to declare all the purchaser's rights hereunder terminated, and upon his doing so, all payments made by the purchaser's rights hereunder and all improvements placed upon the real estate shall be forfeited to the seller as liquidated damages, and the seller shall have right to re-enter and take possession of the real estate; and no waiver by the seller of any default on the part of the purchaser shall be construct as a waiver of any subsequent default.
