hereinster called the "purchaser,"

WITNESSETEL: That the seller agrees to sell to the purchaser and the purchaser agrees to purchase from the seller the following County, State of Washington: described real estate, with the appurtenances, in Skamania

A tract of land located in Government Lot 3 of Section 36, Township 3 North, Range 7/2 E. W. M., described as follows: Beginning at the southwest corner of the said Government Lot 3; thence along the west line of the said Government Lot 3 north 450 feet; thence parallel to the south line of said Lot 3 east 450 feet; thence in a straight line in a south-easterly direction to intersection with the south line of said Government Lot 3 at a point 600 feet distant from the point of beginning; thence west along said south line 600 feet to the point of beginning; EXCEPT that portion thereof conveyed to Glen M. Goodpaster and Velma M. Goodpaster, husband and wife, by deed dated October 16, 1967; and EXCEPT that portion thereof sold to Gail G. Nielson and Sigrid Nielson, husband and wife, by real estate contract dated April 25, 1970; TOGETHER WITH an easement and right of way for an access road 20 feet in width as now constructed and existing and connecting with the public road known and designated as Bone Road.

The terms and conditions of this contract are as follows: The purchase price is Seventeen Thousand and no/100ths One Thousand and no/100ths - - been paid, the receipt whereof is - (\$ 17,000.00) Dollars, of which 1,000.00) Dollars have (\$ been paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and the balance of said purchase price shall be paid as follows:

The purchasers agree to pay the balance of the purchase price in the sum of Sixteen Thousand and no/100ths (\$16,000.00) pollars in monthly installments of One Hundred Thirty and no/100ths (\$130.00) Dollars, or more, commencing on the 20th day of July, 1972, and on the 20th day of each and every month thereafter until the full amount of the purchaseprice together with interest shall have been paid. The said monthly installments shall include interest at the rateof six per-cent (6%) per annum computed on the monthly balances of the unpaid purchase price, and shall be applied first to interest and then to principal. The purchaser reserve the right at any time they are not in default under the terms and conpurchaser; reserve the right at any time they are not in default under the terms and conditions of this contract to pay without penalty any part or all of the unpaid purchase price, plus interest then due. This contract shall not be assigned without the express written consent of the sellers, and any purported assignment thereof without such consent shall be null and void. It is agreed that the purchasers shall have the permissive right to use the existing water system and pipeline to a spring north of said premises for a period of 10 years, but thereafter purchasers agree to terminate such use and develop an alternate water such use alternate Water supply.

As referred to in this contract, "date of closing" shall be ____ June 20, 1972.

(1) The purchaser assum a and agrees to pay before delinquency all taxes and assessments that may as between granter and grantee hereafter become a lieu on aid real estate, and if by the terms of this contract the purchaser has assumed payment of any mortgane, contract or other encur-brance, or has a sumal payment of or agreed to purchase subject to, any taxes or assessments now a lieu on said real estate, the purchaser agrees to pay the same before delinquency.

(2) The purchaser agrees until the purchaser pairs is fully paid to be not be but along the latter agree to purchase pairs is fully paid.

(2) The purchaser agrees, until the purchase price is fully paid, to keep the buildings now and hereafter placed on said real estate insured to the actual cash value thereof against loss or damage by both fire and windstorm in a company acceptable to the seller and for the seller's benefit, as his interest may appear, and to pay all premiums therefor and to deliver all policies and renewals thereof to the seller.

(3) The purchaser agrees that full inspection of said real estate has been made and that neither the seller nor his assigns shall be held to any covenant respecting the condition of any improvements thereon nor shall the purchaser or seller or the assigns of either be held to any covenant or agreement for alterations, improvements or repairs unless the covenant or agreement relied on is contained herein or is in writing and attached to and made a part of this contract.

c. Any existing contract or contracts under which seller is purchasing said real estate, and any mortgage or other obligation, which seller by this contract agrees to pay, none of which for the purpose of this paragraph (5) shall be deemed defects in seller's title

(6) If seller's title to said real estate is subject to an existing contract or contracts under which seller is purchasing said real estate, or any mortgage or other obligation, which seller is to pay, seller agrees to make such payments in accordance with the terms thereof, and upon default, the purchaser shall have the right to make any payments necessary to remove the default, and any payments so made shall be applied to the payments next falling due the seller under this contract. opposed to the payments next making due the sener under this contract.

(7) The celler agrees, upon receiving full psyment of the purchase price and interest in the manner above specified, to execute and deed to said real estate, excepting any part thereof hereafter deliver to purchaser a statutory warranty deed to said real estate, excepting any part thereof hereafter taken for public use, free of encumbrances except any that may attach after date of closing through any person other than the seller, and subject to the following: General taxes for the second half of 1972; Easements and rights of way for record; and The possessory rights of the present occupants under a month to month tenancy. (The purchasers shall have the right to collect any rent falling due on or after June 20, 1972.) (8) Unless a different date is provided for herein, the purchaser shall be entitled to possession of said real estate on date of closing and to retain possession so long as purchaser is not in default hereunder. The purchaser covenants to keep the buildings and other improvaments on said real estate in good repair and not to permit waste and not to use, or permit the use of, the real estate for any illegal purpose. The purchaser covenants to pay all service, installation or construction charges for water, sewer, electricity, garbage or other utility services furnished to said real estate after the date purchaser is entitled to possession.

(9) In case the purchaser fails to make any payment herein provided or to maintain insurance, as herein required, the seller much payment or effect such insurance, and any amounts so paid by the seller, together with interest at the rate of 10% per annum thereon such payment or effect such insurance, and any amounts so paid by the seller, together with interest at the rate of 10% per annum thereon might have by reason of such default.

(10) Time is of the essence of this contract, and it is agreed that in case the purchaser shall fail to comply with or perform any from date of payment until repaid, shall be repayable by purchaser on seller's demand, all without prejudice to any other right the seller might have by reason of such default.

(10) Time is of the essence of this contract, and it is agreed that in case the purchaser shall fall to comply with or perform any condition or agreement hereof or to make any payment required hereunder promptly at the time and in the manner herein required, escaler may elect to declare all the purchaser's rights hereunder terminated, and upon his doing so, all payments made by the texchaser hereunder and all improvements placed upon the real estate shall be forfeited to the seller as liquidated damages, she the seller shall have right to re-enter and take possession of the real estate; and no waiver by the seller of any default on the part of the purchaser shall be construed as a waiver of any subsequent default.

Service upon purchaser of all demands, notices or other papers with respect to forfeiture and termination of purchaser's rights may be made by United States Mail, postage pre-paid, return receipt requested, directed to the purchaser at his address last known to the seller.

(11) Upon seller's election to bring sult to enforce any covenant of this contract, including sult to collect any payment required hereunder, the purchaser agrees to pay a reasonable sum as attorney's fees and all costs and expenses in connection with such suit, which sums shall be included in any judgment or decree entered in such suit.

If the seller shall bring sult to procure an adjudication of the termination of the purchaser's rights hereunder, and judgment is so the reasonable cost of searching records to determine the condition of title at the date such suit is commenced, which sums shall be included in any judgment or decree entered in such suit.
