conveys and quit claims to FRIEDA BLOOMQUIST, a single woman,

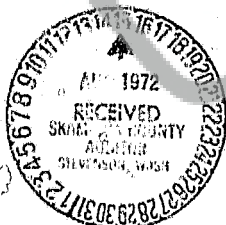
the following described real estate, situated in the County of Skamania
