STEARNS, each dealing with his or her separate property, for and in consideration of the exchange of a parcel of real property belonging to Grantees, convey and warrant to CONRAD LUNDY, JR., and WILLIAM F. WILKINS, as tenants in common, each of their respective interests in the following described real estate:

The Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 26, Twp. 3 N. R. 8 E. W. M. excepting therefrom a strip of land 300 ft. in width acquired by United States of America for Bonneville Transmission line. Also begin at the SE corner of Sec. 26, Twp. 3 N. R. 8 E. W. 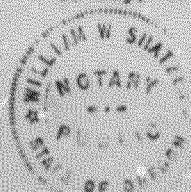
