REAL ESTATE CONTRACT

THIS CONTRACT, made and entered into this

bereinstter called the "seller," and ROBERT L. HECAULEY and ESTHER M. MCCAULEY, husband and wife,

hereing iter called the "purchaser,"

WITNESSETH: That the seller agrees to sell to the purchaser and the purchaser agrees to purchase from the seller the following described real estate, with the appurtenances, in Skamania County, State of Washington:

> Lot 15 of Block Three of JOHNSON'S ADDITION TO THE TOWN OF STEVENSON according to the official plat thereof on file and of record at page 25 of Book A of Plats, Records of Skamania County, Washington.



The terms and conditions of this contract are as follows: The purchase price is THIRTY-FIVE THOUSAND and NO/100 (\$ 35,000.00) Dollars, of which EIGHT THOUSAND and NO/100 (\$8,000.00) Dollars bave been paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and the balance of said purchase price shall be paid as follows:

The purchasers agree to pay the balance of the purchase price in the sum of Twenty-seven Thousand and No/100 (\$27,000,00) Dollars in monthly installments of Two Hundred Fifty and No/100 (\$250.00) Dollars, or more, commencing on the fifteenth day of July, 1974, and on the fifteenth day of each and every month thereafter until the full amount of the purchase price together with interest shall have been paid. The said monthly installments shall include interest at the rate of seven percent (7%) per annum computed upon the monthly balances of the unpaid purchase price. The purchasers reserve the right at any time they are not in default under the terms and conditions of this contract to pay without penalty any part or all of the unpaid purchase price, plus interest, then due.

This contract shall not be assigned without the express written consent of the seller, and any purported assignment thereof without such consent shall be null and void.

(1) The purchaser assumes and agrees to pay before delinquency all taxes and assessments that may as between granter and grantee hereafter become a lien on said real estate; and if by the terms of this contract the purchaser has assumed payment of thy mortgage, contract or other encumbrance, or has assumed payment of or agreed to purchase subject to, any taxes or assessments now a fien on said real estate, the purchaser agrees to pay the same before delinquency.

(2) The purchaser agrees, until the purchase price is fully paid, to keep the buildings now and hereafter placed on said real estate insured to the actual cash value thereof against loss or damage by both fire and windstorm in a company acceptable to the seller and for the seller's benefit, as his interest may appear, and to pay all premiums therefor and to deliver all policies and renewals thereof to the seller.

(3) The purchaser agrees that full inspection of said real estate has been made and that neither the seller nor his assigns shall be held to any covenant respecting the condition of any improvements thereon nor shall the purchaser or seller or the assigns of either be held to any covenant or agreement for alterations, improvements or repairs unless the covenant or agreement relied on is centained herein or is in writing and attached to and made a part of this contract.

(4) The purchaser assumes all hazards of damage to or destruction of any improvements now on said real estate or hereafter placed thereon, and of the taking of said real estate or any part thereof for public use; and agrees that no such damage, destruction or taking shall constitute a failure of consideration. In case any part of said real estate is taken for public use, the portion of the condemnation award remaining after payment of reasonable expenses of procuring the same shall be paid to the seller and applied as payment on the purchase price herein unless the seller elects to allow the purchaser to apply all or a portion of such condemnation award to the rebuilding or restoration of any improvements damaged by such taking, in case of damage or destruction aperil insured against, the proceeds of such insurance remaining after payment of the reasonable expense of procuring the same shall be devicted to the restoration or rebuilding of such improvements within a reasonable time, unless purchaser elects that said proceeds shall be paid to the seller for application on the purchase price herein.

(2) The seller has delivered, or agrees to deliver within 15 days of the date of closing, a parchaser's palicy of little insurance in standard form, or a commitment therefor, issued by from some like insurance Company, insuring the purchaser by the full amount of said purchase price against loss or damage by reason of defect in seller's title to said real estate as of the date of closing and containing no exceptions other than the following:

a. Printed general exceptions appearing in said policy form;
b. Liens or encumbrances which by the terms of this contract the purchaser is to assume, or as to which the conveyance hereunder is to be made subject; and

Any existing contract or contracts under which seller is purchasing said real estate, and any mortgage or other obligation, which seller by this contract agrees to pay, none of which for the purpose of this paragraph (5) shall be deemed defects in relier's title

(6) If seller's title to said real estals is subject to an existing contract or contracts under which seller is purchasing said real estate, or any notificing or other obligation, which seller is to pay, seller agrees to make such payments in accordance with the terms lisered, and up to disfault, the purchaser shall have the right to make any payments necessary to remove the default, and any payments so made shall be applied to the payments next falling due the seller under this contract.

(7) The seller agrees, upon receiving full payment of the purchase price and interest in the manner above specified, to ejecute and deliver to purchaser a statutory warranty deed to said real estate, excepting any part thereof hereafter taken for public use, free of encumbrances except any that may ottach after date of closing through any person other than the seller, and subject to the following: deed to said real estate, excepting any part thereof hereafter

- General taxes for the second half of 1974; and
- The effect, if any, of the municipal ordinances of the Town of Stevenson.

(8) Unless a different date is provided for herein, the purchaser shall be entitled to possession of said real estate on date of closing and to retain possession so long as purchaser is not in default hereunder. The purchaser covenants to keep the buildings and other improvements on said real estates in good repair and not to permit waste and not to use, or permit the use of, the real estate for any blegal purpose. The princhaser covenants to pay all service, installation or construction charges for water, sewer, electricity, parhage or other utility services furnished to said real estate after the date purchaser is entitled to possession.

(9) In case the purchaser faits to make any payment herein provided or to maintain insurance, as herein required, the seller may make such payment or effect such insurance, and any amounts so paid by the seller, tograher with interest at the rate of 10% per annum thereon from date of payment until repaid, shall be repayable by purchaser on seller's demand, all without projudice to any other right the seller might have by reason of such default.

(10) Time is of the essence of this contract, and it is agreed that in case the purchaser shall fall to comply with or perform any condition or agreement hereof or to make any payment required hereunder promptly at the time and in the manner herein required, the sellet say elect to declare all the purchaser's rights hereunder terminated, and upon hi doing so, all payments made by the purchaser hereunder and all improvements placed upon the real estate shall be forfeited to the seller as liquidated damages, and the seller ashall have right to re-enter and take possession of the real estate; and no waiver by the seller as liquidated damages, and the seller shall be construed as a waiver of any subsequent default.

Service upon purchaser of all damands, notices or other papers with respect to forfeiture and termination of purchaser's rights may be made by United States Mail, postage pre-paid, return receipt requested, directed to the purchaser at his address but known to the seller.
