

EASEMENT

THE GRANTORS, REMY W. FULSHER AND BARBARA FULSHER, husband and wife, for themselves, their heirs and assigns, do hereby grant and convey an easement unto THE STATE OF WASHINGTON, THE DEPARTMENT OF GAME for the purposes hereinafter recited on, over, and across the following described lands located in SKAMANIA County, State of Washington, to-wit:

An easement for construction and maintenance of a low-water barrier dam adjacent to the existing Skamania Hatchery water intake on the West Fork of the Washougal River, said easement to be located over a strip of land 25 feet in width and adjacent to and along the Washougal River as measured from the line of ordinary high water of said Washougal River and also over those lands lying between the line of ordinary high water and the thread of said river, beginning at a point on the East line of the Southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 29, Township 2 North, Range 5 East W.M., said point being opposite and at right angles from the center, or thread, of said Washougal River; thence along the right side, downstream, of said river for a distance of 250 feet, all in Section 29, Township 2 North, Range 5 East W.M.

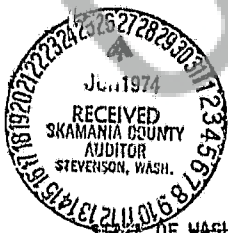
