## REAL ESTATE CONTRACT

THIS CONTRACT, made and entered to this 15th Hay, 1974,

FERN M. PAUL, a Midow,

bereiralter called the "saller," and ROY D. ENGEL and JUDITH A. ENGEL, husband and wife,

hereinafter called the "purchaser,"

WITAESSEXH: That the seller agrees to sell to the purchaser and the purchaser agrees to purchase from the seller the following described real estate, with the appurtenances, in Skamania County, State of Washington:

The said monthly installments shall include interest at the rate of seven percent (7%) per annum computed upon the monthly balances of the unpaid purchase price, and shall be applied first to interest and then to principal. The purchasers reserve the right at any time they are not in default under the terms and conditions of this contract to pay without penalty any part of all of the unpaid purchase price, plus interest, then due.
