The estate taken for said public uses is the 3. 7 perpetual right. power, privilege and easement permanently 8 to overflow, flood and submerge the land described in Schedule "A" as Tract 5211-2, and to maintain mosquito 10 control in connection with the operation and maintenance of 11 the Bonneville Lock and Dam project as authorized by the 12 Act of Congress approved August 20, 1937, and the continuing 13 right to clear and remove any brush, debris and natural ob-10 structions which, in the opinion of the representative of the 15 United States in charge of the project, may be detrimental to the project, together with all right, title and interest 17 in and to the timber, structures and improvements situate 18 on the land; provided that no structures for human 19 habitation shall be constructed or maintained on the land, 20 that no other structures shall be constructed or maintained 21 on the land except as may be approved in writing by the 22 representative of the United States in charge of the 23 project, and that no excavation shall be conducted and 24 no landfill placed on the land without such approval as 25

to the location and method of excavation and/or placement 2 of landfill; the above estate is taken subject to existing easements for public roads and highways, public utilities, 3 railroads and pipelines; reserving, however, to the landowners, their heirs and assigns, all such rights and 5 privileges as may be used and enjoyed without interfering with the use of the project for the purposes authorized by Congress or abridging the rights and easement hereby acquired; provided further that any use of the land shall be subject to Federal and state laws with respect to 10 11 pollution.
