IN THE MATTER OF SR 14 (P.S.H. #3) Cook East to Underwood West

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that THE STATE OF WASHINGTON, for
and in consideration of THREE HUNDRED AND NO/100 (\$300.00) DOLLARS,
hereby conveys and quitclaims unto ALBERT EUGENE STEBINGER and MARY
HELEN STEBINGER, husband and wife, all its right, title and interest, in
and to the following described real property situated in Skamania County,
State of Washington:

The west 450 feet of Government Lot 4, in Section 25, Township
3 North, Range 9 East, W.M., lying northwesterly of a line
parallel to and 100 feet northwesterly from when measured at
right angles and/or radially, to the center line of said SR
14.

The specific details concerning all of which are to be found within
that certain map of definite location now of record and on file in the
Office of the Director of Highways at Olympia, Washington, bearing date
of approval March 6, 1964.

This deed is given in lieu of lost deed dated October 30, 1946
between the same parties.

The lands herein described are not required for State highway
purpose and are conveyed pursuant to the provisions of RCW 47.12.060.
